A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to rabies; to amend sections 71-4401, 71-4402,
 71-4403, 71-4404, 71-4405, 71-4406, 71-4407, 71-4408,
 71-4409, 71-4410, and 71-4412, Reissue Revised Statutes
 of Nebraska; to define and redefine terms; to require
 vaccination of hybrid animals; to prohibit ownership
 of hybrid animals as prescribed; to change penalties;
 to provide for rules and regulations; to harmonize
 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-4401, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 71-4401 For purposes of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412
- 4 and sections 3 and 4 of this act, unless the context otherwise
- 5 requires:
- 6 (1) Domestic animal shall mean means any dog or cat, and
- 7 cat shall mean means a cat which is a household pet;
- 8 (2) Vaccination against rabies shall mean means the
- 9 inoculation of a domestic or hybrid animal with a rabies vaccine
- 10 as approved by the rules and regulations adopted and promulgated
- 11 by the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and
- 12 Licensure. Such vaccination shall be performed by a veterinarian
- 13 duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of
- 14 Nebraska;
- 15 (3) Compendium shall mean means the compendium of animal
- 16 rabies vaccine as provided by the National Association of State
- 17 Public Health Veterinarians;
- 18 (4) Department shall mean means the Department of Health
- 19 and Human Services Regulation and Licensure;
- 20 (5) Hybrid animal means any animal which is the product
- 21 of the breeding of a domestic dog with a nondomestic canine
- 22 <u>species;</u>
- 23 (6) Own, unless otherwise specified, shall mean means
- 24 to possess, keep, harbor, or have control of, charge of, or custody
- 25 of a domestic or hybrid animal. This term shall does not apply

1 to domestic or hybrid animals owned by other persons which are

- 2 temporarily maintained on the premises of a veterinarian or kennel
- 3 operator for a period of not more than thirty days;
- 4 (6) (7) Owner shall mean means any person possessing,
- 5 keeping, harboring, or having charge or control of any domestic
- 6 or hybrid animal or permitting any domestic or hybrid animal to
- 7 habitually be or remain on or be lodged or fed within such person's
- 8 house, yard, or premises. This term shall does not apply to
- 9 veterinarians or kennel operators temporarily maintaining on their
- 10 premises domestic or hybrid animals owned by other persons for a
- 11 period of not more than thirty days; and
- 12 (8) Rabies control authority shall mean means county,
- 13 township, city, or village health and law enforcement officials who
- 14 shall enforce sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of
- 15 this act relating to the vaccination and impoundment of domestic
- 16 or hybrid animals. Such public officials shall not be are not
- 17 responsible for any accident or disease of a domestic or hybrid
- 18 animal resulting from the enforcement of such sections.
- 19 Sec. 2. Section 71-4402, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 20 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 21 71-4402 (1) Every domestic animal in the State of
- 22 Nebraska shall be vaccinated against rabies with a licensed
- 23 vaccine and shall be revaccinated at intervals specified by
- 24 rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the department.
- 25 Young domestic animals shall be initially vaccinated at the age

1 specified in such rules and regulations. Unvaccinated domestic

- 2 animals acquired or moved into the State of Nebraska shall be
- 3 vaccinated within thirty days after purchase or arrival unless
- 4 under the age for initial vaccination.
- 5 (2) The rabies vaccine used to vaccinate domestic
- 6 animals pursuant to this section shall be sold only to licensed
- 7 veterinarians.
- 8 (3) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules
- 9 and regulations for the control and prevention of rabies. Such
- 10 rules and regulations shall generally comply with the compendium
- 11 and the recommendations of the United States Public Health
- 12 Service. The department may consider changes in the compendium
- 13 and recommendations of the United States Public Health Service when
- 14 adopting and promulgating such rules and regulations.
- 15 Sec. 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this
- 16 section, every hybrid animal in the State of Nebraska shall be
- 17 vaccinated against rabies and shall be revaccinated at intervals
- 18 specified by rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the
- 19 department. A young hybrid animal shall be initially vaccinated at
- 20 the age specified in such rules and regulations. An unvaccinated
- 21 hybrid animal acquired or moved into the State of Nebraska shall
- 22 be vaccinated within thirty days after purchase or arrival unless
- 23 under the age for initial vaccination.
- 24 (2) The rabies vaccine used to vaccinate a hybrid
- 25 animal pursuant to this section shall be sold only to licensed

- 1 veterinarians.
- 2 (3) An owner of a hybrid animal in this state prior
- 3 to the date of development of a licensed vaccine determined
- 4 scientifically to be reliable in preventing rabies in a hybrid
- 5 animal shall have one year after such date to comply with this
- 6 section.
- 7 Sec. 4. The department shall adopt and promulgate rules
- 8 and regulations for the control and prevention of rabies. Such
- 9 rules and regulations shall generally comply with the compendium
- 10 and the recommendations of the United States Public Health
- 11 Service. The department may consider changes in the compendium
- 12 and recommendations of the United States Public Health Service when
- 13 adopting and promulgating such rules and regulations.
- 14 Sec. 5. Section 71-4403, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 15 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 16 71-4403 It shall be the duty of each veterinarian, at the
- 17 time of vaccinating any domestic or hybrid animal, to complete a
- 18 certificate of rabies vaccination which shall include, but not be
- 19 limited to, the following information:
- 20 (1) The owner's name and address;
- 21 (2) An adequate description of the domestic or hybrid
- 22 animal, including, but not limited to, such items as the domestic
- 23 or hybrid animal's breed, sex, age, name, and distinctive markings;
- 24 (3) The date of vaccination;
- 25 (4) The rabies vaccination tag number;

- 1 (5) The type of rabies vaccine administered;
- 2 (6) The manufacturer's serial number of the vaccine used;
- 3 and
- 4 (7) The site of vaccination.
- 5 Such veterinarian shall issue a tag with the certificate
- 6 of vaccination.
- 7 Sec. 6. Section 71-4404, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 71-4404 The cost of rabies vaccination shall be borne by
- 10 the owner of the domestic or hybrid animal.
- 11 Sec. 7. Section 71-4405, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 12 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 13 71-4405 (1) The provisions of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412
- 14 and sections 3 and 4 of this act with respect to vaccination
- 15 shall not apply to any domestic or hybrid animal owned by a
- 16 person temporarily remaining within the State of Nebraska for less
- 17 than thirty days, to any domestic or hybrid animal brought into
- 18 the State of Nebraska for field trial or show purposes, or to
- 19 any domestic or hybrid animal brought into the state for hunting
- 20 purposes for a period of less than thirty days. Such domestic or
- 21 hybrid animals shall be kept under strict supervision of the owner.
- 22 It shall be unlawful to bring any domestic or hybrid animal into
- 23 the State of Nebraska which does not comply with the animal health
- 24 laws and import rules and regulations of the State of Nebraska
- 25 which are applicable to domestic or hybrid animals.

1 (2) Domestic or hybrid animals assigned to a research

- 2 institution or a similar facility shall be exempt from sections
- 3 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act.
- 4 Sec. 8. Section 71-4406, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 6 71-4406 (1) Any animal which is owned by a person and has
- 7 bitten any person or caused an abrasion of the skin of any person
- 8 shall be seized by the rabies control authority for a period of not
- 9 less than ten days if:
- 10 (a) The animal is suspected of having rabies, regardless
- 11 of the species and whether or not the animal has been vaccinated;
- 12 (b) The animal is not vaccinated and is of a species
- 13 determined by the department to be a rabid species; or
- 14 (c) The animal is of a species which has been determined
- 15 by the department to be a rabid species not amenable to rabies
- 16 protection by immunization, whether or not such animal has been
- 17 vaccinated.
- 18 If, after observation and examination by a veterinarian,
- 19 at the end of the ten-day period the animal shows no clinical signs
- 20 of rabies, the animal may be released to its owner.
- 21 (2)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (b) of this
- 22 subsection, whenever any person has been bitten or has an abrasion
- 23 of the skin caused by an animal owned by another person, which
- 24 animal has been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402 and
- 25 section 3 of this act, or if such injury to a person is caused by

1 an owned animal determined by the department to be a rabid species

- 2 amenable to rabies protection by immunization which has been
- 3 vaccinated, such animal shall be confined by the owner or other
- 4 responsible person as required by the rabies control authority for
- 5 a period of at least ten days and shall be observed and examined by
- 6 a veterinarian at the end of such ten-day period. If no clinical
- 7 signs of rabies are found by the veterinarian, such animal may be
- 8 released from confinement.
- 9 (b) A vaccinated animal owned by a law enforcement or 10 governmental military agency which bites or causes an abrasion of
- 11 the skin of any person during training or the performance of the
- 12 animal's duties may be confined as provided in subdivision (a) of
- 13 this subsection. Such agency shall maintain ownership of and shall
- 14 control and supervise the actions of such animal for a period of
- 15 fifteen days following such injury. If during such period the death
- 16 of the animal occurs for any reason, a veterinarian shall within
- 17 twenty-four hours of the death examine the tissues of the animal
- 18 for clinical signs of rabies.
- 19 (3) Any animal of a rabid species which has bitten a
- 20 person or caused an abrasion of the skin of a person and which
- 21 is unowned or the ownership of which cannot be determined within
- 22 seventy-two hours of the time of the bite or abrasion shall be
- 23 immediately subject to any tests which the department believes are
- 24 necessary to determine whether the animal is afflicted with rabies.
- 25 The seventy-two-hour period shall include holidays and weekends

1 and shall not be extended for any reason. The tests required by

- 2 this subsection may include tests which require the animal to be
- 3 destroyed.
- 4 Sec. 9. Section 71-4407, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 6 71-4407 In the case of domestic or hybrid animals known
- 7 to have been bitten by a rabid animal, the following rules shall
- 8 apply:
- 9 (1) If the bitten or exposed domestic or hybrid animal
- 10 has not been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402 and
- 11 section 3 of this act, such bitten or exposed domestic or hybrid
- 12 animal shall be immediately destroyed unless the owner is willing
- 13 to place such domestic or hybrid animal in strict isolation in a
- 14 kennel under veterinary supervision for a period of not less than
- 15 six months; and
- 16 (2) If the bitten or exposed domestic or hybrid animal
- 17 has been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402 and section
- 18 3 of this act, such domestic or hybrid animal shall be subject to
- 19 the following procedure: (a) Such domestic or hybrid animal shall
- 20 be immediately revaccinated and confined for a period of not less
- 21 than thirty days following vaccination; (b) if such domestic $\underline{\text{or}}$
- 22 hybrid animal is not immediately revaccinated, such domestic or
- 23 hybrid animal shall be confined in strict isolation in a kennel
- 24 for a period of not less than six months under the supervision
- 25 of a veterinarian; or (c) such domestic or hybrid animal shall be

1 destroyed if the owner does not comply with either subdivision (a)

- 2 or (b) of this subdivision.
- 3 Sec. 10. Section 71-4408, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 5 71-4408 (1) The rabies control authority may authorize an
- 6 animal pound or pounds or may enter into a cooperative agreement
- 7 with a licensed veterinarian for the establishment and operation of
- 8 a pound.
- 9 (2) Any dog or hybrid of the family Canidae found
- 10 outside the owner's premises whose owner does not possess a valid
- 11 certificate of rabies vaccination and valid rabies vaccination
- 12 tag for such dog or hybrid of the family Canidae shall be
- 13 impounded. The rabies control authority may require the impoundment
- 14 of domestic or hybrid animals other than dogs or hybrids of the
- 15 family Canidae. All impounded domestic or hybrid animals shall
- 16 be given proper care, treatment, and maintenance. Each impounded
- 17 domestic or hybrid animal shall be kept and maintained at the pound
- 18 for a period of not less than seventy-two hours unless reclaimed
- 19 earlier by the owner.
- 20 (3) Notice of impoundment of all animals, including any
- 21 significant marks of identification, shall be posted at the pound
- 22 as public notification of impoundment. Any unvaccinated domestic or
- 23 hybrid animal may be reclaimed by its owner during the period of
- 24 impoundment by payment of prescribed pound fees and by complying
- 25 with the rabies vaccination requirement of sections 71-4401 to

1 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act within seventy-two hours

- 2 of release. Any vaccinated domestic or hybrid animal impounded
- 3 because its owner has not presented a valid certificate of rabies
- 4 vaccination and a valid rabies vaccination tag for such domestic
- 5 or hybrid animal may be reclaimed by its owner by furnishing proof
- 6 of rabies vaccination and payment of all impoundment fees prior to
- 7 release.
- 8 (4) At the expiration of impoundment, a domestic or
- 9 hybrid animal may be claimed by payment of established pound
- 10 fees and by compliance with the rabies vaccination requirement of
- 11 sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act within
- 12 seventy-two hours of release. If the domestic or hybrid animal is
- 13 unclaimed at the end of five days, the authorities may dispose of
- 14 the domestic or hybrid animal in accordance with applicable laws or
- 15 rules and regulations.
- 16 Sec. 11. Section 71-4409, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 18 71-4409 The rabies control authority shall enforce
- 19 sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act.
- In the event that the health and law enforcement
- 21 officials of a county, township, city, or village fail to act
- 22 with sufficient promptness in enforcing sections 71-4401 to 71-4412
- 23 and sections 3 and 4 of this act, the department may take all
- 24 actions necessary for the proper administration and enforcement of
- 25 such sections relating to vaccination and impoundment of domestic

1 <u>or hybrid</u> animals. In such a case no authorized representatives

- 2 of the department or any law enforcement officials enforcing such
- 3 sections shall be responsible for any accident or disease of a
- 4 domestic or hybrid animal resulting from the enforcement of such
- 5 sections.
- 6 Sec. 12. Section 71-4410, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 71-4410 The owner of any domestic or hybrid animal or any
- 9 person who violates any of the provisions of sections 71-4401 to
- 10 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be guilty of a Class
- 11 V misdemeanor. When the owner of any domestic or hybrid animal or
- 12 other animal fails or refuses to comply with section 71-4406 or
- 13 71-4407, the rabies control authority shall obtain an order for
- 14 seizure of such animal pursuant to Chapter 29, article 8.
- 15 Sec. 13. Section 71-4412, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 16 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 17 71-4412 In the State of Nebraska, all laws, ordinances,
- 18 codes, or rules and regulations concerning the control of rabies or
- 19 the vaccination of domestic or hybrid animals against rabies shall
- 20 be enforced by the county, township, city, and village health and
- 21 law enforcement officials or those other officers with regulatory
- 22 authority as specified by the governing political subdivisions.
- 23 Whenever a county, township, city, or village requires
- 24 the licensure of domestic or hybrid animals, it may require that,
- 25 before a license is issued for the possession or maintenance of any

1 domestic or hybrid animal in any such county, township, city, or

- 2 village, the owner or keeper of the domestic or hybrid animal shall
- 3 furnish to the clerk of such political subdivision a certification
- 4 that the domestic or hybrid animal has been vaccinated against
- 5 rabies in accordance with sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections
- 6 3 and 4 of this act.
