Section 1. Section 17-503.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 17-503.02 (1) The power of any city of the second class or village to convey any personal property owned by it shall be 4 5 exercised by resolution directing the sale and the manner and terms 6 thereof. of the sale. Following passage of the resolution directing 7 the sale of the property, notice of the sale shall be posted in 8 three prominent places within the city or village for a period of 9 not less than seven days prior to the sale of the property. If the 10 fair market value of the property is greater than five thousand 11 dollars, notice of the sale shall also be published once in a legal 12 newspaper published in or of general circulation in such city or 13 village at least seven days prior to the sale of the property. The 14 notice shall give a general description of the property offered for 15 sale and state the terms and conditions of sale.

16 (2) Personal property may be conveyed notwithstanding the 17 procedure in subsection (1) of this section when (a) such property 18 is being sold in compliance with the requirements of federal or 19 state grants or programs or (b) such property is being conveyed to 20 another public agency.
