A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Convention Center Facility Financing
- 2 Assistance Act; to amend section 13-2603, Revised
- 3 Statutes Supplement, 2007; to redefine terms as
- 4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 13-2603, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2007, is amended to read:
- 3 13-2603 For purposes of the Convention Center Facility
- 4 Financing Assistance Act:
- 5 (1) (1) (a) Associated hotel means any publicly owned
- 6 facility in which the public may, for a consideration, obtain
- 7 sleeping accommodations and which is located within two hundred
- 8 yards of an eligible facility; and
- 9 (b) Beginning with applications for financial assistance
- 10 received on or after February 1, 2008, associated hotel means any
- 11 publicly or privately owned facility in which the public may, for a
- 12 consideration, obtain sleeping accommodations and which is located
- 13 within four hundred fifty yards of an eligible facility, measured
- 14 from the eligible facility but not from any parking facility or
- 15 other structure;
- 16 (2) Board means a board consisting of the Governor,
- 17 the State Treasurer, the chairperson of the Nebraska Investment
- 18 Council, the chairperson of the Nebraska State Board of Public
- 19 Accountancy, and a professor of economics on the faculty of a
- 20 state postsecondary educational institution appointed to a two-year
- 21 term on the board by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary
- 22 Education. For administrative and budget purposes only, the board
- 23 shall be considered part of the Department of Revenue;
- 24 (3) Bond means a general obligation bond, redevelopment
- 25 bond, lease-purchase bond, revenue bond, or combination of any such

- 1 bonds;
- 2 (4) Convention and meeting center facility means a
- 3 temperature-controlled building and personal property primarily
- 4 used as a convention and meeting center, including an auditorium,
- 5 an exhibition hall, a facility for onsite food preparation and
- 6 serving, an onsite, directly connected parking facility for the
- 7 use of the convention and meeting center facility, and an
- 8 onsite administrative office of the convention and meeting center
- 9 facility;
- 10 (5) (5) (a) Eligible facility means any publicly owned
- 11 convention and meeting center facility approved for state
- 12 assistance on or before June 1, 2007, any publicly owned sports
- 13 arena facility attached to such convention and meeting center
- 14 facility, or any publicly or privately owned convention and
- 15 meeting center facility or publicly or privately owned sports arena
- 16 facility acquired, constructed, improved, or equipped after June
- 17 1, 2007; and
- 18 (b) Beginning with applications for financial assistance
- 19 received on or after February 1, 2008, eligible facility does not
- 20 include any publicly or privately owned sports arena facility with
- 21 <u>a seating capacity greater than sixteen thousand seats;</u>
- 22 (6) General obligation bond means any bond or refunding
- 23 bond issued by a political subdivision and which is payable from
- 24 the proceeds of an ad valorem tax;
- 25 (7) Political subdivision means any local governmental

1 body formed and organized under state law and any joint entity

- 2 or joint public agency created under state law to act on behalf
- 3 of political subdivisions which has statutory authority to issue
- 4 general obligation bonds;
- 5 (8) Revenue bond means any bond or refunding bond issued
- 6 by a political subdivision which is limited or special rather than
- 7 a general obligation bond of the political subdivision and which is
- 8 not payable from the proceeds of an ad valorem tax; and
- 9 (9) Sports arena facility means any enclosed
- 10 temperature-controlled building primarily used for competitive
- 11 sports, including arenas, dressing and locker facilities,
- 12 concession areas, parking facilities, and onsite administrative
- 13 offices connected with operating the facilities.
