2		section 30-2483, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3		provide for notice of appointment of a personal
4		representative as prescribed; and to repeal the original

6	Be it	enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 30-2483 Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

30-2483. Unless notice has already been given under this 3 4 article and except when an appointment of a personal representative is 5 made pursuant to subdivision (4) of section 30-2408, the clerk of the 6 court upon the appointment of a personal representative shall publish 7 a notice once a week for three successive weeks in a newspaper of 8 general circulation in the county announcing the appointment and the address of the personal representative, and notifying creditors of the 9 estate to present their claims within two months after the date of the 10 11 first publication of the notice or be forever barred. The first 12 publication shall be made within thirty days after the appointment. 13 The party instituting or maintaining the proceeding or his or her 14 attorney is required to mail the published notice and give proof thereof in accordance with section 25-520.01. For all decedents 15 16 fifty-five years of age or older or who resided in a medical institution as defined in subsection (1) of section 68-1036.02, not 17 later than fourteen days after appointment of a personal 18 representative other than a special administrator, the personal 19 representative shall give written notice of his or her appointment to 20 21 the Department of Health and Human Services Finance and Support. The 22 notice shall include the decedent's name and social security number 23 and, if available upon reasonable investigation, the name and social 24 security number of the decedent's spouse if such spouse is deceased, 25 but the notice need not include a copy of the decedent's will. Sec. 2. Original section 30-2483, Reissue Revised Statutes 26 27 of Nebraska, is repealed.
