## A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to swimming pools; to amend sections 71-4301
2	and 71-4307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
3	sections 71-4303, 71-4304, 71-4305, and 71-4306, Revised
4	Statutes Supplement, 2007; to provide requirements for
5	owners and certified operators as prescribed; to define
6	a term; to harmonize provisions; to provide an operative
7	date; and to repeal the original sections.
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1 Section 1. Section 71-4301, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 71-4301 For purposes of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307
- 4 and sections 2 and 3 of this act, unless the context otherwise
- 5 requires, swimming pool means any artificial basin of water
- 6 modified, improved, constructed, or installed solely for the
- 7 purpose of public swimming, wading, diving, recreation, or
- 8 instruction. Swimming pool includes, but is not limited to, a
- 9 pool serving a community, a subdivision, an apartment complex, a
- 10 condominium, a club, a camp, a school, an institution, a park, a
- 11 manufactured home park, a hotel, a motel, a recreational area, or
- 12 a water park. Swimming pool includes a spa, hot tub, or whirlpool
- 13 or similar device which (1) is designed for recreational use and
- 14 not to be drained, cleaned, and refilled after each individual
- 15 use and (2) may consist of elements, including, but not limited
- 16 to, hydrojet circulation, hot water, cold water, mineral baths,
- 17 air induction systems, or any combination thereof. Swimming pool
- 18 does not include an artificial lake, a pool at a private residence
- 19 intended only for the use of the owner and guests, or a pool
- 20 operated exclusively for medical treatment, physical therapy, water
- 21 rescue training, or training of divers.
- 22 Sec. 2. For purposes of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307 and
- 23 section 3 of this act, certified operator means an individual who
- 24 has successfully completed the Certified Pool-Spa Operator course
- 25 approved by the National Swimming Pool Foundation, the Aquatic

1 Facility Operator course approved by the National Recreation and

- 2 Park Association, or an equivalent course provided by a nonprofit
- 3 organization approved by the Department of Health and Human
- 4 Services. Such course shall provide at least fourteen hours of
- 5 training on pool operation, safety, and maintenance, at least six
- 6 hours of which shall be conducted in a classroom environment
- 7 along with a proctored exam. The remainder of the required
- 8 training may be completed on the Internet, subject to approval
- 9 by the department. A copy of the certification shall be forwarded
- 10 to the department. A certified operator shall maintain his or
- 11 her certification as required by the applicable organization.
- 12 A certified operator shall remit a fee for a certificate of
- 13 competency from the department pursuant to section 71-4305.
- 14 Sec. 3. On and after July 1, 2009, an owner of a
- 15 swimming shall employ at least one certified operator. The owner
- 16 shall replace a vacancy in the certified operator position within
- 17 <u>ninety days of the occurrence of the vacancy if the owner employs</u>
- 18 only one certified operator. A current certificate of a certified
- 19 operator employed by an owner of a swimming pool shall be posted
- 20 conspicuously and maintained at the swimming pool for the duration
- 21 of such employment.
- 22 Sec. 4. Section 71-4303, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 23 2007, is amended to read:
- 24 71-4303 No swimming pool shall be constructed after
- 25 January 1, 1970, unless and until plans, specifications, and any

1 additional information relative to such pool as may be requested

- 2 by the Department of Health and Human Services shall have been
- 3 submitted to such department and after review by such department
- 4 found to comply with section 3 of this act and the minimum sanitary
- 5 and safety requirements provided in section 71-4302 and a permit
- 6 for the construction of the pool issued by such department.
- 7 Sec. 5. Section 71-4304, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 8 2007, is amended to read:
- 9 71-4304 After January 1, 1970, swimming pools shall have
- 10 equipment and shall be operated so as to comply with section
- 11 3 of this act and the minimum sanitary and safety requirements
- 12 provided in section 71-4302. After such date no swimming pool
- 13 shall operate until it has received a permit from the Department
- 14 of Health and Human Services. Application for a permit to operate
- 15 shall be submitted on forms provided by such department. Swimming
- 16 pools constructed prior to January 1, 1970, which do not fully
- 17 comply with the minimum sanitary and safety requirements as regards
- 18 design and construction may be continued in use for such period
- 19 as the department may authorize if the equipment and operation
- 20 of such swimming pool comply with the minimum sanitary and safety
- 21 requirements.
- 22 Sec. 6. Section 71-4305, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 23 2007, is amended to read:
- 24 71-4305 (1) The Department of Health and Human Services
- 25 shall make at least one inspection every year of each swimming pool

1 to determine that such swimming pool complies with section 3 of

- 2 this act and the minimum sanitary and safety requirements provided
- 3 in section 71-4302.
- 4 (2) The owner and operator of any swimming pool or
- 5 a certified operator employed by the owner shall submit such
- 6 operation and analytical records as may be requested at any time
- 7 by the department to determine the sanitary and safety condition of
- 8 the swimming pool.
- 9 (3) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and
- 10 regulations which classify swimming pools on the basis of criteria
- 11 deemed appropriate by the department. The department shall charge
- 12 engineering firms, swimming pool owners, and other appropriate
- 13 parties fees established by rules and regulations for the review
- 14 of plans and specifications of a swimming pool, the issuance of
- 15 a license or permit, the inspection of a swimming pool, and any
- 16 other services rendered at a rate which defrays no more than
- 17 the actual cost of the services provided. All fees shall be paid
- 18 as a condition of annual renewal of licensure or of continuance
- 19 of licensure. All fees collected under this subsection shall be
- 20 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Health and Human
- 21 Services Cash Fund. The department shall not charge a municipal
- 22 corporation an inspection fee for an inspection of a swimming pool
- 23 owned by such municipal corporation.
- 24 (4) The department shall establish and collect fees for
- 25 certificates of competency for swimming pool certified operators as

- 1 provided in sections 38-151 to 38-157.
- Sec. 7. Section 71-4306, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 3 2007, is amended to read:

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71-4306 Whenever any duly authorized representative of 4 5 the Department of Health and Human Services shall find that a 6 swimming pool is being constructed, equipped, or operated in 7 violation of any of the provisions of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307 8 and sections 2 and 3 of this act, the department may grant such 9 time as in its opinion may reasonably be necessary for changing the 10 construction or providing for the proper operation of the swimming 11 pool to meet the provisions of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307 and 12 sections 2 and 3 of this act. If and when the duly authorized 13 representative of the department upon inspection and investigation 14 of a swimming pool considers that the conditions are such as to 15 warrant prompt closing of such swimming pool until the provisions 16 of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307 and sections 2 and 3 of this act are complied with, he or she shall notify the owner or operator 17 18 of the swimming pool or the certified operator employed by the 19 owner to prohibit any person from using the swimming pool and upon 20 such notification to the sheriff and the county attorney of the 21 county in which such pool is located, it shall be the duty of 22 such county attorney and sheriff to see that the notice of the 23 representative of the department shall be enforced. If and when the owner or certified operator of the pool has, in the opinion of 24

the department, met the provisions of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307

1 and sections 2 and 3 of this act, the department may in writing

- 2 authorize the use again of such swimming pool.
- 3 Sec. 8. Section 71-4307, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 5 71-4307 Any owner or operator of a swimming pool or
- 6 certified operator employed by the owner failing to comply with any
- 7 of the provisions of sections 71-4301 to 71-4307 and sections 2 and
- 8 3 of this act shall be guilty of maintaining a public nuisance and
- 9 it shall be the duty of the county attorney of the county in which
- 10 such swimming pool is located to act as provided by law for the
- 11 abatement of public nuisances.
- 12 Sec. 9. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2009.
- Sec. 10. Original sections 71-4301 and 71-4307, Reissue
- 14 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 71-4303, 71-4304,
- 15 71-4305, and 71-4306, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007, are
- 16 repealed.
