## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1163

Introduced by Lautenbaugh, 18.

A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to tanning facilities; to define terms;
- 2 to require posted and signed warnings; and to provide
- 3 penalties.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. For purposes of this act:
- 2 (1) Consumer means an individual who is provided access
- 3 to a tanning facility;
- 4 (2) Operator means an individual designated by the
- 5 tanning facility owner or tanning equipment lessee to operate,
- 6 or to assist and instruct the consumer in the operation and use of,
- 7 the tanning facility or tanning equipment;
- 8 (3) Tanning equipment means ultraviolet or other lamps
- 9 and equipment containing these lamps intended to induce skin
- 10 tanning through the irradiation of any part of the living human
- 11 body with ultraviolet radiation;
- 12 (4) Tanning facility means a location, place, area,
- 13 structure, or business or a part thereof which provides consumers
- 14 access to tanning equipment. Tanning facility includes, but is
- 15 not limited to, tanning salons, health clubs, apartments, or
- 16 condominiums regardless of whether a fee is charged for access to
- 17 the tanning equipment; and
- 18 (5) Ultraviolet radiation means electromagnetic radiation
- 19 with wavelengths in air between two hundred nanometers and four
- 20 <u>hundred nanometers</u>.
- 21 Sec. 2. This act does not apply to:
- 22 (1) A person who (a) uses equipment which emits
- 23 ultraviolet radiation incidental to its normal operation and (b)
- 24 does not use such equipment to deliberately expose parts of the
- 25 living human body to ultraviolet radiation for the purpose of

- 1 tanning or other treatment;
- 2 (2) A physician licensed under the Uniform Licensing Law
- 3 prior to December 1, 2008, or the Uniform Credentialing Act on
- 4 and after December 1, 2008, who uses, in the practice of medicine,
- 5 medical diagnostic and therapeutic equipment that emits ultraviolet
- 6 radiation; or
- 7 (3) An individual who owns tanning equipment exclusively
- 8 for personal, noncommercial use.
- 9 Sec. 3. (1) A tanning facility owner or tanning equipment
- 10 lessee shall conspicuously post the warning sign described in this
- 11 section within three feet of each piece of tanning equipment. The
- 12 sign shall be clearly visible, not be obstructed by any barrier,
- 13 equipment, or other object, and be posted so that it can be easily
- 14 viewed by the consumer before using the tanning equipment.
- 15 (2) The warning sign required by this section shall have
- 16 the following wording:
- DANGER!!!
- 18 ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION
- 19 Frequent use or overexposure leads to accumulation
- 20 of ultraviolet radiation, which may cause skin cancers, such
- 21 as malignant melanoma, squamous cell carcinoma, or basal cell
- 22 carcinoma, eye injury, or other skin damage or injury, including
- 23 premature aging of the skin, or allergic reactions.
- 24 <u>Medications or cosmetics may increase your sensitivity</u>
- 25 to the ultraviolet radiation. Consult a physician before using a

1 sunlamp or tanning equipment if you are using medications or have

- 2 a history of skin problems or believe yourself to be especially
- 3 sensitive to sunlight.
- 4 (3) The warning sign required by this section shall be
- 5 printed on white paper, eight and one-half inches by eleven inches
- 6 in size. The warning sign shall be available and must be obtained
- 7 from the Department of Health and Human Services in its required
- 8 wording, paper, font color and size, and format specifications
- 9 by mail or electronic means. The word DANGER!!! shall be in
- 10 size forty-six Arial-style font, in red ink, underlined, and
- 11 italicized. The words ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION shall be in size
- 12 forty-two Arial-style font, in red ink, underlined, and italicized.
- 13 The words in the first paragraph of the warning shall be in size
- 14 twenty-eight Arial-style bold font, with the words skin cancers
- 15 underlined and in red link and the words malignant melanoma,
- 16 squamous cell carcinoma, and basal cell carcinoma underlined. The
- 17 words in the second paragraph of the warning shall be in size
- 18 twenty-four Arial-style bold font.
- 19 Sec. 4. (1) A tanning facility owner or tanning equipment
- 20 lessee shall require the operator to provide each consumer, before
- 21 initial exposure to the tanning equipment at such facility, with
- 22 a copy of the warning described in this section which shall be
- 23 signed, witnessed, and dated as indicated in the warning.
- 24 (2) The warning required by this section shall be printed
- 25 on a plain white sheet of paper, eight and one-half inches by

1	eleven inches in size, with the words in no less than size sixteen,
2	Arial-style font.
3	WARNING
4	This warning must be read and signed by the consumer

22	Sec. 5. The owner or lessee of a tanning facility shall
23	provide a copy of a warning completed pursuant to section 4 of this
24	act to the consumer who signed the form and shall maintain the
25	original copy of such warning for a period of ten years.

Sec. 6. The owner or lessee of a tanning facility shall

- 2 make the original copies of signed warning forms available for
- 3 inspection by the Department of Health and Human Services or any
- 4 person designated by the department at any time during the normal
- 5 business hours of the facility.
- 6 Sec. 7. Any person who leases tanning equipment or who
- 7 owns a tanning facility and who operates or permits the equipment
- 8 or facility to be operated in violation of the requirements of this
- 9 act is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. Any operator who violates
- 10 the requirements of this act is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor.
