Section 1. Section 76-14,109 Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

76-14,109. (1) If a tenant abandons a mobile home on a mobile home space, the mobile home may shall not be removed from the mobile home space by the tenant or his or her agent without a signed written authorization from the landlord granting clearance for removal, showing all money due and owing paid in full, or an agreement reached with the legal owner and the landlord. A mobile home shall be is considered to be abandoned if the tenant has defaulted in rent and has, by absence of at least thirty days or by words or actions, reasonably indicated an intention not to continue the tenancy.

(2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a landlord from removing an abandoned mobile home <u>and its contents</u> from the mobile space and placing <u>it</u> the mobile home and its contents in storage at the owner's expense or from utilizing any other legal remedy.

(3) For purposes of disposition, an abandoned mobile home shall be treated as personal property. Disposition of the mobile home and its contents shall be governed by the Disposition of Personal Property Landlord and Tenant Act.

Sec. 2. Original section 76-14,109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
