A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to labor; to amend sections 48-2102, 48-2104,
 48-2107, 48-2114, and 48-2115, Reissue Revised Statutes
 of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to the
 Contractor Registration Act; and to repeal the original
 sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 48-2102, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 48-2102 It is the intent of the Legislature that all
- 4 contractors doing business in counties with a population of over
- 5 one hundred thousand inhabitants Nebraska be registered with the
- 6 department. It is not the intent of the Legislature to endorse
- 7 the quality or performance of services provided by any individual
- 8 contractor.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 48-2104, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 10 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 11 48-2104 Before performing any construction work in any
- 12 county with a population of over one hundred thousand inhabitants,
- 13 Nebraska, a contractor shall be registered with the department. If
- 14 a contractor does business under more than one name, the contractor
- 15 shall obtain a registration number for each name under which the
- 16 contractor is doing business.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 48-2107, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 18 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 19 48-2107 (1) Each application or renewal under section
- 20 48-2105 shall be accompanied by a fee of twenty-five one hundred
- 21 dollars. The fee shall not be required when an amendment to an
- 22 application is submitted.
- 23 (2) A contractor shall not be required to pay the fee if
- 24 the application contains an affidavit which shows the contractor
- 25 is self-employed and does not pay more than one thousand dollars

1 annually to employ other persons in the business. with a maximum

- 2 equivalent of one full-time employee at any one time. The affidavit
- 3 shall contain (a) a statement that the contractor is self-employed,
- 4 and (b) a list of all employees employed on the date of the
- 5 application and in the past twelve-month period prior to such date
- 6 and the dates of employment for each employee. the amount paid to
- 7 each employee, and (c) a list of all current employees. At any time
- 8 that a contractor no longer qualifies for exemption from the fee,
- 9 the fee shall be paid to the department.
- 10 Sec. 4. Section 48-2114, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 11 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 12 48-2114 (1) The commissioner shall issue a citation to a
- 13 contractor when an investigation reveals that the contractor has
- 14 violated:
- 15 (a) The requirement that the contractor be registered; or
- 16 (b) The requirement that the contractor's registration
- 17 information be substantially complete and accurate.
- 18 (2) If When a citation is issued, the commissioner shall
- 19 notify the contractor of the proposed administrative penalty,
- 20 if any, by certified mail or any other manner of delivery by
- 21 which the United States Postal Service can verify delivery. The
- 22 administrative penalty shall be not more than five hundred thousand
- 23 dollars in the case of a first violation and not more than five ten
- 24 thousand dollars in the case of a second or subsequent violation.
- 25 (3) The contractor shall have fifteen working days from

1 the date of the citation or penalty to contest such citation or

- 2 penalty. Notice of contest shall be sent to the commissioner who
- 3 shall provide a hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedure
- 4 Act.
- 5 Sec. 5. Section 48-2115, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 6 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 7 48-2115 There is hereby created the Contractor
- 8 Registration Cash Fund to be administered by the department and
- 9 <u>used to enforce the Contractor Registration Act</u>. The fund shall
- 10 consist of such sums as are appropriated to it by the Legislature
- 11 and any fees collected in the administration of the Contractor
- 12 Registration Act. act. All funds collected shall be remitted to
- 13 the State Treasurer for credit to the fund. Any money in the fund
- 14 available for investment shall be invested by the state investment
- 15 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the
- 16 Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 17 Sec. 6. Original sections 48-2102, 48-2104, 48-2107,
- 18 48-2114, and 48-2115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are
- 19 repealed.
