FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission of Industrial Relations; to
amend section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
to change the judges' compensation; and to repeal the
original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 211

Section 1. Section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 48-806. As soon as such compensation the same may be 3 legally paid under the Constitution of Nebraska, the compensation of 4 judges each judge of the Commission of Industrial Relations shall 5 6 be two hundred fifty dollars paid per day for each day's time 7 actually engaged in the performance of the duties of their office. The per diem rate shall be the daily equivalent of a district judge's annual salary under section 24-301.01. Each judge shall also be paid 9

his or her necessary traveling expenses incurred while away from his

or her place of residence upon business of the commission in

accordance with sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.
