 5 to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
 6 sections.

3	53-180.04 Every licensee of a place where alcoholic
4	liquor is sold at retail shall display at all times in a prominent
5	place a printed card with a minimum height of twenty inches and
6	a width of fourteen inches, with each letter to be a minimum of
7	one-fourth inch in height, which shall read as follows:

- 15 paper, or legal document that may be used to establish the age of
- 16 the person named thereon for the purpose of purchasing alcoholic

- 18 $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ When a minor is arrested for a violation of
- 19 sections 53-180 to 53-180.02 or subsection (2) (3) of this section,
- 20 the law enforcement agency employing the arresting peace officer
- 21 shall make a reasonable attempt to notify such minor's parent or
- 22 guardian of the arrest.
