A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to political subdivisions; to amend sections 23-149, 23-202, 23-292, 23-293, 23-294, and 51-201.03, 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change and 3 4 eliminate provisions relating to county organization; to 5 change provisions relating to establishment of a county б library; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original 7 sections; and to outright repeal sections 23-283, 23-287, 23-290, and 23-291, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska. 8 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 23-149, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

Whenever in In counties not 3 23-149. under township organization, a registered voter may file a petition or petitions 4 5 for the submission of the question regarding the number of 6 commissioners the county will have, signed by not less than two 7 hundred registered voters of the county voting at the last general 8 election, on the county board. The petition or petitions shall be signed by registered voters equal in number to five percent of the 9 voters registered in the county at the preceding statewide general 10 11 election. When the petition or petitions are filed in the office of 12 the county clerk or election commissioner not less than seventy days before the date of any general election, the county clerk or election 13 14 commissioner shall cause the question to be submitted to the voters of the county at such election and give notice thereof in the general 15 16 notice of such election. The forms of ballots shall be respectively: For three commissioners and For five commissioners; and the same shall 17 be printed upon the regular ballots cast for officers voted for at 18 such election and shall be counted and canvassed in the same manner. 19 20 If a majority of votes cast at the election favor the proposition For 21 five commissioners, thereafter the county shall have five 22 commissioners, and if a majority of the ballots cast at the election 23 favor the proposition For three commissioners, thereafter the county 24 shall have three commissioners.

Sec. 2. Section 23-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

23-202. The county commissioners on petition of two hundred

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1 and fifty or more legal voters of the county, shall cause to be submitted to the voters of the county In counties not under 2 3 township organization, a registered voter may file a petition or petitions for the submission of the question of 4 township 5 organization. The petition or petitions shall be signed by 6 registered voters equal in number to five percent of the voters 7 registered in the county at the preceding statewide general election. 8 When the petition or petitions are filed in the office of the county clerk or election commissioner, the question shall be submitted to 9 10 the registered voters at the next general election held not less than 11 seventy days after the filing of the petitions. The questions on the 12 ballot shall be respectively: , by ballot, to be written or 13 printed, or partly written or partly printed thereon For township 14 organization, or Against township organization. Elections shall be conducted as provided in the Election Act. , the votes to be 15 16 counted, canvassed, and returned in like manner as votes for county 17 officers.

19 Nebraska, is amended to read:

20 23-292. Any county which may have adopted or that may 21 hereafter adopt has township organization shall discontinue the 22 same whenever the majority of the electors of said registered 23 voters of the county voting on the question of such discontinuance 24 shall so decide in the manner herein provided <u>in sections 23-293</u> 25 <u>to 23-295</u>.

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1	23-293. Whenever <u>(1) In counties under township</u>
2	organization, a registered voter may file a petition or petitions for
3	${f a}$ submission of the question of the discontinuance of township
4	organization to the <u>registered</u> voters of the county <u>. The petition</u>
5	or petitions shall be signed by registered voters equal in number to
6	five percent of the voters registered in the county at the preceding
7	statewide general election. When the petition or petitions are filed
8	in the office of the county clerk or election commissioner, the
9	question shall be submitted to the registered voters at the next
10	general election held not less than seventy days after the filing of
11	the petitions.
12	(2) In counties under township organization, if , signed
13	by a number of electors not less than ten percent of those voting at
14	the last general election, or a resolution supported by a majority
15	of the county board is filed in the office of the county clerk or
16	election commissioner <u>for submission of the question of</u>
17	discontinuance of township organization to the registered voters of
18	the county, the question shall be submitted to the registered voters
19	at the next general election held not less than seventy days after
20	the filing of the resolution. not less than seventy days before the
21	date of any general election, the county clerk or election
22	commissioner shall cause such question to be submitted to the voters
23	of the county at such election and give notice of the submission of
24	the question in the general election notices of such election.

26	Nebraska, is amended to read:
27	23-294. (1) The forms of ballots shall be respectively,

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1 For continuance of township organization, and Against continuance of 2 township organization. , and the same shall be written or printed 3 upon the regular ballot cast for officers voted for at such election, 4 and shall be counted and canvassed in the same manner. 5 (2) Elections shall be conducted regarding discontinuance of township organization as provided in the Election Act. 6 7 6. Section 51-201.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Sec. 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:

51-201.03. (1) The registered voters of the incorporated and 9 unincorporated areas of a county which do not have a public library 10 11 may file an initiative petition with the county board requesting the 12 establishment of a county library. The petition shall be filed by July 31 prior to a statewide general election. Signatures gathered before 13 14 the last statewide general election shall not be counted. An initiative petition shall conform to the requirements of section 15 16 32-628. Petition signers and petition circulators shall conform to the requirements of sections 32-629 and 32-630. The county board shall 17 submit the petitions to the election commissioner or county clerk for 18 signature verification pursuant to section 32-631. The required number 19 of signatures shall be ten five percent of the voters registered 20 at the last statewide general election in the incorporated and 21 22 unincorporated areas of the county which do not have a public library. 23 The election commissioner or county clerk shall notify the county 24 board within thirty days after receiving the petitions from the county 25 board whether the required number of signatures has been gathered. (2) If the county board determines that the petitions are in 26

27 proper form and signed by the necessary number of registered voters,

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the county board shall notify the governing body and library board of 1 2 each incorporated area within the county within ten days after such determination and shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation 3 in the county that the registered voters of the unincorporated area of 4 5 the county and of the incorporated areas which do not have a public 6 library will be asked to vote on the issue at the next statewide 7 general election and shall submit the question of whether to establish 8 a county library to the voters as required in section 51-201. 9 Sec. 7.
