Section 1. Section 46-601.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 46-601.01 For purposes of Chapter 46, article 6:

4 (1) (1) (a) Water well means any excavation that is 5 drilled, cored, bored, washed, driven, dug, jetted, or otherwise 6 constructed for the purpose of exploring for ground water, 7 monitoring ground water, utilizing the geothermal properties of 8 the ground, obtaining hydrogeologic information, or extracting 9 water from or injecting fluid as defined in section 81-1502 into 10 the underground water reservoir.

11 (b) Water well includes any excavation made for any 12 purpose if ground water flows into the excavation under natural 13 pressure and a pump or other device is placed in the excavation 14 for the purpose of withdrawing water from the excavation for 15 irrigation. For such excavations, construction means placing a pump 16 or other device into the excavation for the purpose of withdrawing 17 water for irrigation.

18 (c) Water well does not include any excavation made for 19 obtaining or prospecting for oil or natural gas or for inserting 20 media to repressure oil or natural gas bearing formations regulated 21 by the Nebraska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission; and

(2) Common carrier means any carrier of water including a
pipe, canal, ditch, or other means of piping or adjoining water for
irrigation purposes.

2 46-1212 Water well shall mean any excavation that is 3 drilled, cored, bored, washed, driven, dug, jetted, or otherwise constructed for the purpose of exploring for ground water, 4 monitoring ground water, utilizing the geothermal properties of 5 6 the ground, obtaining hydrogeologic information, or extracting 7 water from or injecting fluid as defined in section 81-1502 into 8 the underground water reservoir. Water well shall not include 9 any excavation (1) made for obtaining or prospecting for oil or 10 natural gas or for inserting media to repressure oil or natural 11 gas bearing formations regulated by the Nebraska Oil and Gas 12 Conservation Commission or (2) described in subdivision (1) (b) of 13 section 46-601.01.

Sec. 3. Original sections 46-601.01 and 46-1212, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
