Section 1. Section 43-2,119 Reissue Revised Statutes of

- Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 43-2,119. (1) The number of judges of the separate juvenile
- 4 court in counties which have established a separate juvenile court
- 5 shall be:
- 6 (a) Two judges in counties having seventy-five thousand
- 7 inhabitants but less than two hundred thousand inhabitants;
- 8 (b) Three Four judges in counties having at least two
- 9 hundred thousand inhabitants but less than four hundred thousand
- 10 inhabitants; and
- 11 (c) Five judges in counties having four hundred thousand
- inhabitants or more.
- 13 (2) The senior judge in point of service as a juvenile court
- 14 judge shall be the presiding judge. The judges shall rotate the office
- of presiding judge every three years unless the judges agree to
- 16 another system.
- 17 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2007.
- 18 Sec. 3. Original section 43-2,119, Reissue Revised Statutes
- of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 20 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 21 when passed and approved according to law.
