## LEGISLATIVE BILL 40

## A BILL

1	FOR AN	ACT relating to elections; to amend sections 32-1404,
2		32-1406, and 32-1546, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
3		to require an initiative and referendum petition circulator
4		to wear an identification badge; to harmonize provisions;
5		and to repeal the original sections.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 32-1404 Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

32-1404. (1) A signer of an initiative and referendum 3 4 petition shall be a registered voter of the State of Nebraska on or 5 before the date on which the petition is required to be filed with the 6 Secretary of State and shall meet the requirements of section 32-630. 7 (2) A person who circulates initiative and referendum 8 petitions need not be a registered voter but shall comply with requirements of subsection (2) of section 32-630 and with the 9 prohibitions contained in subdivisions (3)(a), (d), and (f) of section 10 11 32-630. A person circulating such petitions shall wear an 12 identification badge as provided in section 32-1406 so that the identification number is visible to petition signers. 13

14Sec. 2. Section 32-1406 Reissue Revised Statutes of15Nebraska, is amended to read:

16 32-1406. (1) The election commissioner or county clerk 17 shall provide the name and address of the principal circulator of an 18 initiative or referendum petition upon request. The principal 19 circulator shall inform the election commissioner or county clerk of 20 the name and address to be provided.

## (2) The principal circulator shall provide an

identification badge to each person who circulates his or her petition. The principal circulator shall keep a record of the identification badges being used and the name and address of each person to whom he or she gives an identification badge. The principal circulator shall make the records available, upon request, to the Secretary of State, the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure

1Commission, and law enforcement personnel. The identification badges2shall each have a unique number and a brief description of the3subject matter of the petition in a print size and style easily read4by a petition signer. A person wearing an identification badge shall5make sure it is visible by and legible to petition signers.6Sec. 3. Section 32-1546 Reissue Revised Statutes of7Nebraska, is amended to read:

8 32-1546. (1) Any person who is not, at the time of signing a petition, a registered voter and qualified to sign the petition except 9 as provided for initiative and referendum petitions in section 10 11 32-1404 or who signs any name other than his or her own to any petition, or who fails to wear an identification badge as required by 12 section 32-1404 shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor 13 14 (2) Any person who falsely swears to a circulator's affidavit on a petition, who accepts money or other things of value 15 16 for signing a petition, or who offers money or other things of value in exchange for a signature upon any petition shall be guilty of a 17 Class IV felony. 18
