- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to dental hygienists; to amend sections
 2 71-193.15 and 71-193.17, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- Nebraska; to change provisions relating to authorized
- 4 procedures; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-193.15, Reissue Revised Statutes of

2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 71-193.15 A licensed dental hygienist shall perform the traditional dental hygiene functions set forth in section 71-193.17 4 5 only when authorized to do so by a licensed dentist who shall be responsible for the total oral health care of the patient. The 6 7 Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure 8 in the conduct of public health-related services in a public 9 health setting may authorize a licensed dental hygienist to: 10 Conduct conduct preliminary charting and screening examinations; τ provide oral health education for patients including the teaching 11 12 of appropriate plaque control techniques; inspect the oral cavity; 13 perform pulp vitality testing; and apply fluorides, sealants, and 14 other recognized topical agents for the prevention of oral disease 15 to children who are eligible to receive services under the Medical 16 Assistance Act. For purposes of this section, public health setting 17 means a federal or state public health facility, community clinic, 18 or other program or agency that primarily serves public health 19 care program recipients. The licensed dental hygienist shall (1) 20 provide a copy of a report of treatment to the Department of Health 21 and Human Services Regulation and Licensure and show proof of professional liability coverage, (2) advise the patient and legal 22 23 guardian that the services are preventive in nature and do not 24 constitute a comprehensive dental diagnosis and care, and (3) not

be eligible as a provider under the Medical Assistance Act. $_{7}$ and

- 5 71-193.17 When properly authorized and directed, a
- 6 licensed dental hygienist, under the general supervision of a
- 7 licensed dentist, may perform the following intra and extra oral
- 8 procedures:
- 9 (1) Scaling of teeth, including subgingival regions
- 10 and root planing with hand and ultrasonic instruments; Oral
- 11 prophylaxis, peridontal scaling, and root planing which includes
- 12 supragingival and subgingival debridement;
- 13 (2) Polish all exposed tooth surfaces, including
- 14 with motor-driven and hand instruments in the oral prophylaxis
- 15 procedure, including polishing amalgam restorations;
- 16 (3) Conduct preliminary charting and screening
- 17 examinations and indexing of dental and periodontal disease;
- 18 (4) Brush biopsies;
- 19 (5) Pulp vitality testing;
- 20 (4) Periodontal probing and charting;
- 21 (6) Gingival curettage;
- 22 (6) Place and remove periodontal dressings;
- 23 (7) Remove sutures;
- 24 (8) Provide preventive measures, such as the application
- 25 of fluorides, sealants, and other recognized topical agents for the

- 1 prevention of oral disease;
- 2 (9) Provide impressions for study casts;
- 3 (10) Apply topical desensitizing and subgingival agents;
- 4 (11) Provide radiographic exposures;
- 5 (12) Provide oral health education, including conducting
- 6 workshops and inservice training sessions on dental health; for
- 7 patients including the teaching of appropriate plaque control
- 8 techniques; and
- 9 (13) Perform or provide all of the duties that any dental
- 10 assistant is authorized to perform; and -
- 11 (14) Apply or dispense antimicrobial rinses, fluorides,
- 12 and other anticariogenic agents and, in the case of a patient of
- 13 record with a previous prescription for an antimicrobial rinse,
- 14 fluoride, or other anticariogenic agent, authorize a refill of such
- 15 prescription.
