A BILL

1	FOR AN	ACT relating to radiation; to amend sections 71-1734 and
2		71-3508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to exempt
3		certified registered nurse anesthetists from certain
4		radiation-use qualifications; and to repeal the original
5		sections.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-1734, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

71-1734. (1) The determination and administration of total
anesthesia care shall be performed by the certified registered nurse
anesthetist or a nurse anesthetist temporarily certified pursuant to
section 71-1731 in consultation and collaboration with and with the
consent of the licensed practitioner.

8 (2) The following duties and functions shall be considered 9 as specific expanded role functions of the certified registered nurse 10 anesthetist:

11 (a) Preanesthesia evaluation including physiological studies 12 to determine proper anesthetic management and obtaining informed 13 consent;

14 (b) Selection and application of appropriate monitoring 15 devices;

16 (c) Selection and administration of anesthetic techniques; 17 (d) Evaluation and direction of proper postanesthesia 18 management and dismissal from postanesthesia care; and

19 (e) Evaluation and recording of postanesthesia course of 20 patients<u>; and</u> -

(f) Administration of medication through the use of fluoroscopy to locate the precise point to inject such medication. For purposes of this subdivision, certified registered nurse anesthetists are not subject to the qualification requirements in the department's rules and regulations adopted and promulgated under subdivision (3)(a) of section 71-3508.

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(3) The determination of other duties that are normally

1 considered medically delegated duties to the certified registered 2 nurse anesthetist or to a nurse anesthetist temporarily certified pursuant to section 71-1731 shall be the joint responsibility of the 3 governing board of the hospital, medical staff, and nurse anesthetist 4 5 personnel of any duly licensed hospital or, if in an office or clinic, 6 the joint responsibility of the duly licensed practitioner and nurse 7 anesthetist. All such duties, except in cases of emergency, shall be 8 in writing in the form prescribed by hospital or office policy. 9 2. Section 71-3508, Reissue Revised Sec. Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read: 10

11 71-3508. (1) The department shall require each person who 12 possesses or uses a source of radiation to maintain records relating 13 to its receipt, storage, transfer, or disposal and such other records 14 as the department may require subject to such exemptions as may be 15 provided by rules or regulations. These records shall be made 16 available for inspection by or copies shall be submitted to the 17 department on request.

18 (2) The department shall require each person who possesses or uses a source of radiation to maintain appropriate records showing 19 20 radiation exposure of all individuals for the whom personnel monitoring is required by rules and regulations of the department. 21 22 Copies of these records and those required to be kept by subsection 23 (1) of this section shall be submitted to the department on request. Any person possessing or using a source of radiation shall furnish to 24 25 each employee for whom personnel monitoring is required a copy of each employee's personal exposure record at any time such employee has 26 27 received exposure in excess of the amount specified in the rules and

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regulations of the department and upon termination of employment. A
 copy of the annual exposure record shall be furnished to the employee
 as required under rules and regulations adopted under the Radiation
 Control Act.

5 (3) (3)(a) The department may adopt and promulgate rules 6 and regulations establishing qualifications pertaining to the 7 education, knowledge of radiation safety procedures, training, 8 experience, utilization, facilities, equipment, and radiation 9 protection program that an individual user of sources of radiation 10 shall possess prior to using any source of radiation or

11 radiation-generating equipment.

12 (b) Individuals who are currently licensed in the State of Nebraska as podiatrists, chiropractors, dentists, physicians and 13 14 surgeons, osteopathic physicians, physician assistants, and veterinarians shall be exempt from the rules and regulations of the 15 16 department pertaining to the qualifications of persons for the use of X-ray radiation-generating equipment operated for diagnostic purposes. 17 Sec. 3. Original sections 71-1734 and 71-3508, Reissue 18 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed. 19

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
