Section 1. Section 60-6,265, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 60-6,265 For purposes of sections 60-6,266 to 60-6,273, occupant protection system means a system utilizing a lap belt, a 4 5 shoulder belt, or any combination of belts installed in a motor 6 vehicle which (1) restrains drivers and passengers and (2) conforms 7 to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards, 49 C.F.R. 571.207, 8 571.208, 571.209, and 571.210, as such standards existed on January 9 1_7 2006, or to the federal motor vehicle safety standards for 10 passenger restraint systems applicable for the motor vehicle's 11 model year as the standards existed on the effective date of this 12 act or as the standards existed when the occupant protection system 13 was originally installed. In the case of a school bus, occupant 14 protection system means a system utilizing a lap belt, a shoulder 15 belt, or any combination of belts installed in a school bus which 16 restrains drivers and passengers and conforms to standards, federal 17 or otherwise, that are appropriate for the size and type of school

18 bus as the standards existed on the effective date of this act.
