A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Political Accountability and
2	Disclosure Act; to amend sections 49-1449, 49-1463.02,
3	and 49-14,140, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
4	section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
5	2006; to provide registration fees for committees;
6	to provide for waiver of interest as prescribed;
7	to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
8	sections.

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1 Section 1. Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,141 and section 3 of
- 4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political
- 5 Accountability and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 49-1449, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 49-1449 (1) Each committee shall file a statement of
- 9 organization pursuant to this section and pay a registration fee
- 10 pursuant to section 3 of this act with the commission. Except
- 11 as provided in subsection (2) of this section, such statement of
- 12 organization shall be filed and fee paid within ten days after a
- 13 committee is formed. The commission shall maintain a statement of
- 14 organization filed by a committee until notified of the committee's
- 15 dissolution. Any person who fails to file with the commission a
- 16 statement of organization required by this subsection shall pay
- 17 to the commission a late filing fee of twenty-five dollars for
- 18 each day the statement remains not filed in violation of this
- 19 subsection, not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars.
- 20 (2) If the committee is formed within thirty days prior
- 21 to an election for which the committee exists, the statement of
- 22 organization shall be filed and registration fee paid within two
- 23 business days after the committee is formed. Any person who fails
- 24 to file with the commission a statement of organization required by
- 25 this subsection shall pay to the commission a late filing fee of

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1 one hundred dollars for each day the statement remains not filed in

- 2 violation of this subsection, not to exceed one thousand dollars.
- 3 Sec. 3. (1) At the time that each committee files
- 4 its statement of organization pursuant to section 49-1449, the
- 5 committee shall pay to the commission a registration fee of one
- 6 hundred dollars. The filing of a statement of organization is not
- 7 perfected unless accompanied by the registration fee.
- 8 (2) A committee which has not perfected its filing of a
- 9 statement of organization by the date due shall not make or receive
- 10 contributions or expenditures until such time as the filing of the
- 11 statement of organization is perfected, except that:
- 12 (a) A committee may make an expenditure to pay the
- 13 registration fee; and
- 14 (b) A committee may make expenditures for thirty days
- 15 after the termination of its registration if the expenditures
- 16 are part of the process of dissolving the committee and the
- 17 committee dissolves within thirty days after the termination of its
- 18 registration.
- 19 (3) The registration of each committee may be renewed by
- 20 the payment of an annual registration fee of one hundred dollars.
- 21 The fee shall be paid to the commission on or before December 31 of
- 22 each calendar year. The registration of a committee shall terminate
- 23 on December 31 of the year in which the committee is registered
- 24 <u>unless the registration is renewed.</u>
- 25 (4) A committee whose registration has terminated shall

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1 not make or receive contributions or expenditures until such time

- 2 as the registration of the committee is renewed.
- 3 (5) The registration of any committee in existence as of
- 4 the effective date of this act shall continue without the payment
- 5 of a registration fee until December 31 following the effective
- 6 date of this act.
- 7 (6) The registration fees collected pursuant to this
- 8 section shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
- 9 Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission Cash Fund.
- 10 Sec. 4. Section 49-1463.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 11 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 12 49-1463.02 Interest shall accrue on all late filing
- 13 fees and civil penalties imposed under the Nebraska Political
- 14 Accountability and Disclosure Act at the rate specified in section
- 15 45-104.02, as such rate may from time to time be adjusted. The
- 16 interest shall begin to accrue thirty days after the commission
- 17 sends notice to the person of the assessment of the late filing
- 18 fee or civil penalty. A written request filed with the commission
- 19 for relief from late filing fees shall stay the accrual of interest
- 20 on a late filing fee until such time as the commission grants or
- 21 denies the request. The commission may waive the payment of accrued
- 22 interest in the amount of twenty-five dollars or less.
- 23 Sec. 5. Section 49-14,140, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 24 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 25 49-14,140 The Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure

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1 Commission Cash Fund is hereby created. The fund shall consist

- 2 of funds received by the commission pursuant to sections 49-1470,
- 3 49-1480.01, 49-1482, 49-1495, 49-14,123, and 49-14,123.01 and
- 4 section 3 of this act. The fund shall not include late filing
- 5 fees or civil penalties assessed and collected by the commission.
- 6 The fund shall be used by the commission in administering the
- 7 Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act. Any money in
- 8 the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state
- 9 investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act
- 10 and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 11 Sec. 6. Original sections 49-1449, 49-1463.02, and
- 12 49-14,140, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
- 13 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006, are
- 14 repealed.
