1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission on Mexican-Americans; to
2	amend sections 81-8,262, 81-8,265, and 81-8,270, Reissue
3	Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 81-8,271.01,
4	Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to rename
5	the commission and a fund; to harmonize provisions; and
6	to repeal the original sections.
7	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-8,262, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 81-8,262 There is hereby created the Commission on
- 4 Mexican-Americans hereinafter referred to as the commission.
- 5 Hispanic-Americans. For purposes of sections 81-8,262 to
- 6 81-8,271.01, commission means the Commission on Hispanic-Americans.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 81-8,265, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 81-8,265 The functions of the commission shall be to:
- 10 (1) Gather and disseminate information and conduct
- 11 hearings, conferences, and special studies on problems and programs
- 12 concerning Mexican-Americans; Hispanic-Americans;
- 13 (2) Serve the needs of Mexican-Americans,
- 14 Hispanic-Americans, especially in the fields of education,
- 15 employment, health, housing, welfare, and recreation by offering
- 16 such services as it may establish for the translation of documents
- 17 and for the direct assistance of clients, exclusive of legal
- 18 representation, in matters relating to any federal department or
- 19 agency or any department or agency of the state or a political
- 20 subdivision thereof;
- 21 (3) Develop, coordinate, and assist public and private
- 22 organizations and coordinate and assist the efforts of state
- 23 departments and agencies to serve the needs of Mexican-Americans;
- 24 Hispanic-Americans;
- 25 (4) Propose new programs concerning Mexican-Americans;

- 2 (5) Evaluate existing programs and proposed legislation
- 3 concerning Mexican-Americans;
- 4 (6) Stimulate public awareness of the problems of
- 5 Mexican-Americans Hispanic-Americans by conducting a program of
- 6 public education and encourage the Governor and the Legislature to
- 7 develop programs to deal with these problems; and
- 8 (7) Conduct training programs for community leadership
- 9 and service project staff.
- 10 Sec. 3. Section 81-8,270, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 11 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 12 81-8,270 The director may employ any subordinate
- 13 personnel necessary to assist him or her in the performance of his
- 14 or her duties, including clerical staff and technical advisors. The
- 15 director may employ assistant directors if necessary to develop,
- 16 assist, and cooperate with local commissions on Mexican-Americans.
- 17 Hispanic-Americans.
- 18 Sec. 4. Section 81-8,271.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 19 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 20 81-8,271.01 The Commission on Mexican-Americans
- 21 Hispanic-Americans Cash Fund is created. The Commission on
- 22 Mexican-Americans Hispanic-Americans shall use the fund for
- 23 commission functions described in sections 81-8,262 to 81-8,271.
- 24 Money credited to the fund shall include any monetary gifts,
- 25 grants, and donations. Any money in the fund available for

1 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer

- 2 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 3 State Funds Investment Act. Any money remaining in the Commission
- 4 on Mexican-Americans Cash Fund on the effective date of this act
- 5 shall be transferred to the Commission on Hispanic-Americans Cash
- 6 Fund on such date.
- 7 Sec. 5. Original sections 81-8,262, 81-8,265, and
- 8 81-8,270, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
- 9 81-8,271.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006, are
- 10 repealed.
