1 Section 1. Section 79-1312, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 79-1312 Sections 79-1312 to 79-1325 and sections 2 to
- 4 5 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
- 5 Educational Telecommunications Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds that the programming and
- 7 media produced by and provided through the Nebraska Educational
- 8 Telecommunications Commission is important to the state in many
- 9 ways, including educationally, historically, culturally, and
- 10 socially. The Legislature further finds that federal funding
- 11 for public broadcasting is vulnerable and without guarantee of
- 12 continuation. In order to ensure a stable source of funding
- 13 for future generations, the Legislature proposes to establish
- 14 a financial partnership between the commission and the private
- 15 sector.
- 16 Sec. 3. (1) The Nebraska Educational Telecommunications
- 17 Programming Endowment Fund is created. The fund shall consist of
- 18 funds appropriated or transferred by the Legislature. Only the
- 19 earnings of the fund may be used as provided in this section.
- 20 (2) The State Treasurer shall designate fifty million
- 21 dollars of the Cash Reserve Fund as the Nebraska Educational
- 22 Telecommunications Programming Endowment Fund as provided in
- 23 section 84-612.
- 24 (3) Any money in the Nebraska Educational
- 25 Telecommunications Programming Endowment Fund available for

1 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer

- 2 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 3 State Funds Investment Act.
- 4 (4) Any interest accruing on the Nebraska Educational
- 5 Telecommunications Programming Endowment Fund shall be credited to
- 6 the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund.
- 7 Sec. 4. (1) The Nebraska Educational Telecommunications
- 8 Programming Trust Fund is created. The fund shall consist of
- 9 interest credited pursuant to section 3 of this act. The Nebraska
- 10 Educational Telecommunications Commission shall administer and
- 11 distribute the fund.
- 12 (2) All disbursements from the fund shall be matched
- 13 dollar-for-dollar by sources other than state funds except as
- 14 specifically authorized in this section.
- 15 (3) The matching funds shall be money generated from
- 16 endowments established by the commission or qualified endowments
- 17 of constituent organizations, money generated as a result of
- 18 programming grants to the commission or constituent organizations
- 19 that are from sources other than state funds, or money generated
- 20 by the commission or constituent organizations for programming and
- 21 operations not funded by state funds. Money used as a match shall
- 22 be limited to matching the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications
- 23 Programming Trust Fund in the state fiscal year prior to the state
- 24 fiscal year in which the money is received. The matching funds
- 25 required by this section shall not include in-kind contributions.

1 Any interest accruing on the money in the Nebraska Educational

- 2 Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund shall be counted as
- 3 matching funds.
- 4 (4) For an endowment to be a qualified endowment (a)
- 5 the endowment shall meet the standards set by the commission or
- 6 its constituent organizations, (b) the endowment shall be intended
- 7 for long-term sustainability and stabilization of the organization,
- 8 and (c) the funds of the endowment shall be endowed and only the
- 9 earnings thereon expended.
- 10 (5) An organization is a constituent organization if it
- 11 provides programming and operational funding in support of Nebraska
- 12 educational telecommunications and is tax exempt under section 501
- of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 14 (6) The budget division of the Department of
- 15 Administrative Services shall approve allotment and disbursement of
- 16 funds from the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Programming
- 17 Trust Fund only to the extent that the commission has provided
- 18 documentation of the dollar-for-dollar match required by this
- 19 section.
- 20 (7) Funds from the Nebraska Educational
- 21 Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund may be used for the
- 22 purpose of obtaining challenge grants from the National Endowment
- 23 for the Humanities or the National Endowment for the Arts.
- 24 (8) The commission shall adopt and promulgate rules and
- 25 regulations to provide that the ultimate use of disbursements from

1 the fund shall be limited to programming and operational expenses

- 2 which are not used for fundraising purposes and are not directly
- 3 supported by the General Fund appropriation to the commission.
- 4 (9) Any money in the Nebraska Educational
- 5 Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund available for investment
- 6 shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 7 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 8 Investment Act.
- 9 Sec. 5. The Nebraska Educational Telecommunications
- 10 Commission shall report to the Clerk of the Legislature
- 11 and Director of Administrative Services annually regarding
- 12 <u>disbursements from the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications</u>
- 13 Programming Trust Fund. The report shall include a complete listing
- 14 of the uses of the fund, the sources of funding used to match
- 15 state funds, the amount of investment earnings credited to the
- 16 Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund, and
- 17 the balance of the fund. The report shall cover the period July 1
- 18 through June 30 and shall be submitted no later than November 1
- 19 of each year.
- 20 Sec. 6. Section 79-1320, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 21 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 22 79-1320 The State Educational Telecommunications Fund
- 23 is created. The fund shall be used by the Nebraska Educational
- 24 Telecommunications Commission for the purposes of carrying out the
- 25 provisions of the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Act other

1 than as provided in section 79-1321 and sections 2 to 5 of this

- 2 act. Such fund shall consist of such sums as the Legislature
- 3 may appropriate. Any money in the fund available for investment
- 4 shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 5 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 6 Investment Act.
- 7 Sec. 7. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 8 2007, is amended to read:
- 9 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state
- 10 treasury a fund known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under
- 11 the direction of the State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used
- 12 pursuant to this section.
- 13 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the
- 14 Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the
- 15 Director of Administrative Services that the current cash balance
- 16 in the General Fund is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such
- 17 certification shall include the dollar amount to be transferred.
- 18 Any transfers made pursuant to this subsection shall be reversed
- 19 upon notification by the Director of Administrative Services that
- 20 sufficient funds are available.
- 21 (3) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the
- 22 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department
- 23 of Administrative Services, shall transfer such amounts not to
- 24 exceed seven million seven hundred fifty-three thousand two hundred
- 25 sixty-three dollars in total from the Cash Reserve Fund to the

1 Nebraska Capital Construction Fund between July 1, 2003, and June

- 2 30, 2007.
- 3 (4) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 4 administrator, shall transfer an amount equal to the total amount
- 5 transferred pursuant to subsection (3) of this section from the
- 6 General Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund on or before June 30, 2008.
- 7 (5) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds,
- 8 the Cash Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the
- 9 State of Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes,
- 10 federal revenue sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.
- 11 (6) On June 15, 2007, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 12 fifteen million six hundred seventy-four thousand one hundred seven
- 13 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund.
- 14 (7) On June 16, 2008, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 15 seventeen million nine hundred thirty-one thousand thirty dollars
- 16 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund.
- 17 (8) On June 15, 2009, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 18 four million nine hundred ninety thousand five hundred five dollars
- 19 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund.
- 20 (9) On or before June 16, 2008, the State Treasurer, at
- 21 the direction of the budget administrator, shall transfer fifty
- 22 million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund.
- 23 (10) On or before June 16, 2009, the State Treasurer,
- 24 at the direction of the budget administrator, shall transfer fifty
- 25 million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund.

1 (11) From the effective date of an endowment agreement

- 2 as defined in subdivision (3)(c) of section 79-1101 until June
- 3 30, 2007, forty million dollars of the Cash Reserve Fund shall be
- 4 deemed to constitute the Early Childhood Education Endowment Fund.
- 5 Such funds shall remain part of the Cash Reserve Fund for all
- 6 purposes, except that the interest earned on such forty million
- 7 dollars shall accrue as provided in section 84-613.
- 8 (12) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 9 administrator, shall transfer such amounts, as certified by the
- 10 Director of Administrative Services, for employee health insurance
- 11 claims and expenses, not to exceed twelve million dollars in total
- 12 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the State Employees Insurance Fund
- 13 between May 1, 2007, and June 30, 2011.
- 14 (13) On July 9, 2007, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 15 twelve million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska
- 16 Capital Construction Fund.
- 17 (14) On July 9, 2007, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 18 five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Job Training
- 19 Cash Fund. The State Treasurer shall transfer from the Job Training
- 20 Cash Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund such amounts as directed in
- 21 section 81-1201.21.
- 22 (15) On July 7, 2008, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 23 five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Job Training
- 24 Cash Fund. The State Treasurer shall transfer from the Job Training
- 25 Cash Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund such amounts as directed in

- 1 section 81-1201.21.
- 2 (16) On or before August 1, 2007, the State Treasurer,
- 3 at the direction of the budget administrator, shall transfer
- 4 seventy-five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the
- 5 Nebraska Capital Construction Fund.
- 6 (17) On or before June 30, 2009, the State Treasurer
- 7 shall transfer nine million five hundred ninety thousand dollars
- 8 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction
- 9 Fund.
- 10 (18) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 11 administrator, shall transfer an amount equal to the total amount
- 12 transferred pursuant to subsection (12) of this section from
- 13 the appropriate health insurance accounts of the State Employees
- 14 Insurance Fund in such amounts as certified by the Director of
- 15 Administrative Services to the Cash Reserve Fund on or before June
- 16 30, 2011.
- 17 (19) On July 9, 2007, the State Treasurer shall
- 18 transfer one million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the
- 19 Microenterprise Development Cash Fund.
- 20 (20) On July 9, 2007, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 21 two hundred fifty thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to
- 22 the Building Entrepreneurial Communities Cash Fund.
- 23 (21) On July 7, 2008, the State Treasurer shall
- 24 transfer one million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the
- 25 Microenterprise Development Cash Fund.

1 (22) On July 7, 2008, the State Treasurer shall transfer

- 2 two hundred fifty thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to
- 3 the Building Entrepreneurial Communities Cash Fund.
- 4 (23) Beginning August 1, 2008, fifty million dollars of
- 5 the Cash Reserve Fund shall be deemed to constitute the Nebraska
- 6 Educational Telecommunications Programming Endowment Fund. Such
- 7 fifty million dollars shall remain part of the Cash Reserve Fund
- 8 for all purposes except that the interest earned on the amount in
- 9 the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Programming Endowment
- 10 Fund shall accrue as provided in section 84-613.
- 11 Sec. 8. Section 84-613, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 12 2007, is amended to read:
- 13 84-613 Any money in the Cash Reserve Fund available
- 14 for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer
- 15 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 16 State Funds Investment Act. Until July 1, 2007, any interest
- 17 earned by the fund shall accrue to the General Fund, except
- 18 for interest earned on forty million dollars if such money
- 19 is deemed to constitute the Early Childhood Education Endowment
- 20 Fund in accordance with subsection (11) of section 84-612.
- 21 From the effective date of an endowment agreement as defined
- 22 in subdivision (3)(c) of section 79-1101 until June 30, 2007,
- 23 interest earned on the forty million dollars deemed to constitute
- 24 the Early Childhood Education Endowment Fund shall accrue to
- 25 the Early Childhood Education Endowment Cash Fund. Commencing

1 July 1, 2007, any Any interest earned by the Cash Reserve

- 2 Fund shall accrue to the General Fund, except that interest
- 3 earned on the fifty million dollars deemed to constitute the
- 4 Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Programming Endowment Fund
- 5 in accordance with section 84-612 shall accrue to the Nebraska
- 6 Educational Telecommunications Programming Trust Fund.
- 7 Sec. 9. Original sections 79-1312 and 79-1320, Reissue
- 8 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 84-612 and 84-613,
- 9 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007, are repealed.
