Section 1. Section 60-3,123, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2007, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,123 (1) Any person who was captured and incarcerated
- 4 by an enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with
- 5 such enemy and who was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 6 characterization of honorable from or is currently serving in the
- 7 United States Armed Forces may, in addition to the application
- 8 required in section 60-385, apply to the department for license
- 9 plates designed to indicate that he or she is a former prisoner of
- 10 war.
- 11 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant
- 12 paying the regular license fee and an additional fee of five
- 13 dollars and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that
- 14 the applicant was formerly a prisoner of war. The additional fee
- 15 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Highway
- 16 Trust Fund. Only one motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin
- 17 trailer Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or
- 18 cabin trailers owned by an applicant shall may be so licensed at
- 19 any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section
- 20 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.

- 22 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the license plates
- 23 shall be issued replacement license plates upon request and without

- 7 disabled may, in addition to the application required in section
- 8 60-385, apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for license
- 9 plates designed by the department to indicate that the applicant is
- 10 a disabled veteran. The inscription on the license plates shall be
- 11 D.A.V. immediately below the license plate number to indicate that
- 12 the holder of the license plates is a disabled veteran.
- 13 (2) The plates shall be issued upon the applicant paying
- 14 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
- 15 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
- 16 is a disabled veteran. The additional fee shall be remitted to
- 17 the State Treasurer for credit to the Highway Trust Fund. Only one
- 18 motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer Any number
- 19 of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned
- 20 by the applicant shall may be so licensed at any one time. Motor
- 21 vehicles and trailers registered under section 60-3,198 shall not
- 22 be so licensed.
