A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
2 28-1206, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to possession of a deadly weapon by a
4 felon; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-1206, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-1206 (1) Any person who possesses any firearm, knife,
4 or brass or iron knuckles and who has previously been convicted
5 of a felony or who is a fugitive from justice commits the offense
6 of possession of a deadly weapon by a felon or a fugitive from
7 justice.

8 (2) Such felony conviction may have been had in any
9 court in the United States, the several states, territories, or
10 possessions, or the District of Columbia.

11 (3) (a) Possession of a deadly weapon other than a firearm
12 by a felon or a fugitive from justice is a Class IV felony.

13 (b) Possession of a deadly weapon which is a firearm by a
14 felon or a fugitive from justice is a Class III felony.
