3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2008 the

To amend Article III, section 7:

one-half the members of the Legislature, or as nearly thereto as may be practicable, shall be elected for a term of four years and the remainder for a term of two years, and thereafter all members shall be elected for a term of four years, with the manner of such election to be determined by the Legislature. When the Legislature is redistricted, the members elected prior to the redistricting shall continue in office, and the law providing for such redistricting shall where necessary specify the newly established district which they

shall represent for the balance of their term. Each member shall be

nominated and elected in a nonpartisan manner and without any

indication on the ballot that he or she is affiliated with or endorsed by any political party or organization. Each Until January 7. 2009, each member of the Legislature shall receive a salary of not to exceed one thousand dollars per month during the term of his or her office. Beginning January 7, 2009, each member of the Legislature shall receive an annual salary during his or her term of office equal to one thousand dollars adjusted for inflation as determined by the Legislature since the last salary increase for members of the Legislature and every two years thereafter. In addition to his or her salary, each member shall receive an amount equal to his or her actual expenses in traveling by the most usual route once to and returning from each regular or special session of the Legislature. Members of the Legislature shall receive no pay nor perquisites other than his or her salary and expenses, and employees of the Legislature shall receive no compensation other than their salary or per diem. Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article section 1, following ballot XVI, with the language: A constitutional amendment to change the salary of the the Legislature based on adjustments members of for inflation as determined by the Legislature.
