

## Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 902

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

**LB 902** would amend Neb.Rev.Stat. § 28-405 to classify (a) oripavine as a Schedule II controlled substance and (b) tramadol as a Schedule IV controlled substance. The legislation would establish a requirement for registrants who are manufacturing, distributing, storing or dispensing controlled substances in Schedule I, II, III, IV or V to prepare an annual, rather than a biennial, inventory of each controlled substance in his or her possession. The bill would also require an exact annual count or measure of all Schedule I, II, III, IV and V controlled substances. The revisions to the inventory requirements would take effect on January 1, 2009.
