Sec. 4. Section 37-327, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

6 37-327 (1) The commission shall establish fees for 7 licenses, permits, stamps, bands, registrations, and certificates issued under the Game Law and the State Boat Act and shall 8 9 establish the fee required by section 37-562 as provided in such 10 law, act, and section. The commission shall not increase any fee 11 more than six percent in any one per year, except that if a fee has not been increased by such percentage in a the immediately prior 12 13 year after 1993, the difference between a six percent increase 14 and the actual percentage increase in such prior year may be 15 added to the percentage increase in a subsequent the following 16 year. Such fees shall be collected and disposed of as provided 17 in such law, act, and section. The commission shall, as provided 18 in such law, act, and section, establish issuance fees to be retained by authorized agents of such licenses, permits, stamps, 19 20 bands, registrations, and certificates under such law, act, and 21 section. The commission shall establish such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations. 22

(2) Prior to establishing any fee, the commission shall,

1 at least thirty days prior to the hearing required in section 2 84-907, make the following information available for public review: 3 (a) The commission's policy on the minimum cash balance 4 to be maintained in the fund in which the revenue from the fee 5 being established is deposited and the justification in support of 6 such policy;

7 (b) Monthly estimates of cash fund revenue, expenditures, 8 and ending balances for the current fiscal year and the following 9 two fiscal years for the fund in which the revenue from the fee 10 being established is deposited. Estimates shall be prepared for 11 both the current fee schedule and the proposed fee schedule; and

12 (c) A statement of the reasons for establishing the fee13 at the proposed level.

14 (3) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and 15 regulations to establish fees for expired licenses, permits, 16 stamps, bands, registrations, and certificates issued under the 17 Game Law and the State Boat Act. The commission shall collect the 18 fees and remit them to the State Treasurer for credit to the State 19 Game Fund.
