Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 274 would allow the Director of Corrections to assign convicted felons under the Department of Corrections care to incarceration work camps. LB 274 would prohibit any felon convicted of a sexual assault as provided under Neb. Rev. Stat. 28-319 through 28-321 and felons convicted of any capital crime from being placed at an incarceration work camp.
