Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 420 extends a sales tax exemption for non-profit hospitals to other facilities. The facilities now included in this exempt status would be health care practitioner facilities owned or controlled by a non-profit hospital, and health care practitioner facilities which receive federal funds from the United States Public Health Service for serving medically under-served populations.

Explanation of amendments:

The Committee adopted AM710 which clarifies the original intent of the bill by specifying the health care entities exempt from sales tax under current law. The amendment also includes language originally included in LB 165 dealing with activities and services provided at sales tax exempt facilities in the amendment.
