Section 1. Section 81-8,262, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-8,262 There is hereby created the Commission on
4 Mexican-Americans hereinafter referred to as the commission.
5 Latino-Americans. For purposes of sections 81-8,262 to 81-8,271.01,
6 commission means the Commission on Latino-Americans.

7 Sec. 2. Section 81-8,265, Reissue Revised Statutes of

9 81-8,265 The functions of the commission shall be to:

10 (1) Gather and disseminate information and conduct 11 hearings, conferences, and special studies on problems and programs 12 concerning <u>Mexican-Americans; Latino-Americans;</u>

13 (2) Serve the needs of Mexican-Americans, 14 Latino-Americans, especially in the fields of education, 15 employment, health, housing, welfare, and recreation by offering 16 such services as it may establish for the translation of documents 17 and for the direct assistance of clients, exclusive of legal 18 representation, in matters relating to any federal department or 19 agency or any department or agency of the state or a political 20 subdivision thereof;

(3) Develop, coordinate, and assist public and private organizations and coordinate and assist the efforts of state departments and agencies to serve the needs of <u>Mexican-Americans</u>; <u>Latino-Americans</u>;

(4) Propose new programs concerning Mexican-Americans;

Sec. 3. Section 81-8,270, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

12 81-8,270 The director may employ any subordinate 13 personnel necessary to assist him or her in the performance of his 14 or her duties, including clerical staff and technical advisors. The 15 director may employ assistant directors if necessary to develop, 16 assist, and cooperate with local commissions on Mexican-Americans. 17 Latino-Americans.

18 Sec. 4. Section 81-8,271.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
19 Nebraska, is amended to read:

20 81-8,271.01 The Commission on Mexican-Americans 21 Latino-Americans Cash Fund is created. The Commission on 22 Latino-Americans shall Mexican-Americans use the fund for 23 commission functions described in sections 81-8,262 to 81-8,271. Money credited to the fund shall include any monetary gifts, 24 25 grants, and donations. Any money in the fund available for

Any money remaining in the Commission on Mexican-Americans Cash Fund on the effective date of this act 4 shall be transferred to the Commission on Latino-Americans Cash 5 6 Fund on such date. 7 Sec. 5. Original sections 81-8,262, 81-8,265, 81-8,270,

8 and 81-8,271.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are 9 repealed.
