A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 81-2,147
2	and 81-2,162.22, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
3	to provide that state law preempts local law for the
4	Nebraska Seed Law and the Nebraska Commercial Fertilizer
5	and Soil Conditioner Act; to harmonize provisions; and to
6	repeal the original sections.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1	Section 1. The Nebraska Seed Law and any rules and
2	regulations adopted and promulgated thereunder shall supersede and
3	preempt any ordinance, rule, regulation, or resolution enacted by
4	any political subdivision of the state regarding the regulation
5	of seeds. No political subdivision shall prohibit or in any other
6	manner regulate any matter relating to the registration, labeling,
7	or sale of seeds based upon the type, nature, or genetic makeup of
8	such seeds. No political subdivision shall prohibit or in any other
9	manner regulate any matter relating to the registration, labeling,
10	sale, storage, transportation, distribution, notification of use,
11	planting, or cultivation of seeds that is in addition to or in
12	conflict with the Nebraska Seed Law and any rules and regulations
13	adopted and promulgated thereunder. Nothing in this section shall
14	be construed to preempt or otherwise limit the authority of any
15	city or county to adopt and enforce zoning regulations.

19	of this act shall be known and cited as the Nebraska Seed Law.
20	Sec. 3. The Nebraska Commercial Fertilizer and Soil
21	Conditioner Act and any rules and regulations adopted and
22	promulgated thereunder shall supersede and preempt any ordinance,
23	rule, regulation, or resolution enacted by any political
24	subdivision of the state regarding the regulation of fertilizer and
25	soil conditioners. No political subdivision shall prohibit or in

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1 any other manner regulate any matter relating to the registration, 2 labeling, or sale of fertilizer and soil conditioners. No political 3 subdivision shall prohibit or in any other manner regulate any matter relating to the storage, transportation, distribution, 4 notification of use, or use that is in addition to or in conflict 5 with the Nebraska Commercial Fertilizer and Soil Conditioner Act 6 7 and any rules and regulations adopted and promulgated thereunder. 8 Nothing in this section shall be construed to preempt or otherwise 9 limit the authority of any city or county to adopt and enforce 10 zoning regulations or any natural resources district to enforce the Nebraska Ground Water Management and Protection Act. 11 12 Sec. 4.
