 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate liability with
 respect to governmental agencies as prescribed; and to
 repeal the original section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 54-601, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 54-601 (1) Dogs are hereby declared to be personal
- 4 property for all intents and purposes, and, except as provided in
- 5 subsection (2) of this section, the owner or owners of any dog
- 6 or dogs shall be liable for any and all damages that may accrue
- 7 (1) (a) to any person, other than a trespasser, by reason of
- 8 having been bitten by any such dog or dogs and (2) (b) to any
- 9 person, firm, or corporation by reason of such dog or dogs killing,
- 10 wounding, injuring, worrying, or chasing any person or persons or
- 11 any sheep or other domestic animals belonging to such person, firm,
- 12 or corporation. Such damage may be recovered in any court having
- 13 jurisdiction of the amount claimed.
- 14 (2)(a) A governmental agency or its employees using a dog
- 15 in military or police work shall not be liable under subsection (1)
- of this section to a party to, participant in, or person reasonably
- 17 suspected to be a party to or participant in the act that prompted
- 18 the use of the dog in the military or police work if the officers
- 19 of the governmental agency were complying with a written policy on
- 20 the necessary and appropriate use of a dog for military or police
- 21 work adopted by the governmental agency and if the damage occurred
- 22 while the dog was responding to a harassing or provoking act or
- 23 the damage was the result of a reasonable use of force while the
- 24 dog or dogs were assisting an employee of the agency in any of the
- 25 <u>following:</u>

1 (i) The apprehension or holding of a suspect if the

- 2 employee has a reasonable suspicion of the suspect's involvement in
- 3 criminal activity;
- 4 (ii) The investigation of a crime or possible crime;
- 5 (iii) The execution of a warrant; or
- 6 (iv) The defense of a peace officer or another person
- 7 other than the suspect.
- 8 (b) For purposes of this subsection, harassing or
- 9 provoking act means knowingly and intentionally attempting to
- 10 interfere with, interfering with, teasing or harassing such dog in
- order to distract, or agitating or harming such dog.
