Section 87-214, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 87-214 The Secretary of State shall cancel from the 4 register: (1) Any registration concerning which the Secretary of 5 6 State shall receive a voluntary request for cancellation from the 7 registrant or the assignee of record; 8 (2) Any registration granted under sections 87-208 to 9 87-220 and not renewed in accordance with such sections; 10 (3) Any registration concerning which a court of 11 competent jurisdiction shall find: 12 (a) That the registered trade name has been abandoned; 13 (b) That the registrant is not the owner of the trade 14 name; 15 (c) That the registration was granted improperly; or 16 (d) That the registration was obtained fraudulently; 17 Any registration that a court of competent (4) 18 jurisdiction shall order canceled on any ground; and 19 (5) Any registration where the registrant has failed to 20 publish such trade name within thirty forty-five days from the 21 filing in the office of the Secretary of State and filing proof of 22 publication with the Secretary of State and county clerk within the 23 thirty forty-five days. 25 Nebraska, is amended to read:

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87-219 Every duplicate of the registration of a trade name shall be published by the applicant once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city or village where the business is to be located, or, if there is no newspaper in the city or village, in some newspaper of general circulation in the county. Proof of such publication shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State and with the county clerk of the county wherein the principal office is located, within thirty forty-five days from the date of registration in the office of the Secretary of State. If proof of publication is not filed with the Secretary of State and county clerk within the thirty forty-five days, the registration shall be canceled by the Secretary of State.

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Sec. 3. Original sections 87-214 and 87-219, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
