#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-3,122,
  60-3,123, and 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Supplement,
  2009; to remove a limitation on issuance of Pearl Harbor,
  prisoner-of-war, and disabled veteran license plates as
  prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-3,122, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2009, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,122 (1) Any person may, in addition to the
- 4 application required by section 60-385, apply to the department
- 5 for license plates designed by the department to indicate that he
- 6 or she is a survivor of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor if he
- 7 or she:
- 8 (a) Was a member of the United States Armed Forces on
- 9 December 7, 1941;
- 10 (b) Was on station on December 7, 1941, during the hours
- 11 of 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor, the island
- 12 of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to exceed three miles;
- 13 (c) Was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 14 characterization of honorable from the United States Armed Forces;
- 15 and
- 16 (d) Holds a current membership in a Nebraska Chapter of
- 17 the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association.
- 18 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant
- 19 paying the regular license fee and an additional fee of five
- 20 dollars and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that
- 21 the applicant fulfills the requirements provided by subsection (1)
- 22 of this section. The additional fee shall be remitted to the
- 23 State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System
- 24 Operation Fund. Only one motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or
- 25 cabin trailer owned by the applicant shall be so licensed at any

1 one time. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or

- 2 cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any one
- 3 time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section 60-3,198
- 4 shall not be so licensed.
- 5 (3) If the license plates issued pursuant to this section
- 6 are lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall
- 7 be issued replacement license plates upon request and without
- 8 charge.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 60-3,123, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 10 2009, is amended to read:
- 11 60-3,123 (1) Any person who was captured and incarcerated
- 12 by an enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with
- 13 such enemy and who was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 14 characterization of honorable from or is currently serving in the
- 15 United States Armed Forces may, in addition to the application
- 16 required in section 60-385, apply to the department for license
- 17 plates designed to indicate that he or she is a former prisoner of
- 18 war.
- 19 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant
- 20 paying the regular license fee and an additional fee of five
- 21 dollars and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that
- 22 the applicant was formerly a prisoner of war. The additional fee
- 23 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska
- 24 Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund. Only one motor vehicle,
- 25 trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer owned by an applicant shall

1 be so licensed at any one time. Any number of motor vehicles,

- 2 trailers, semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by the applicant
- 3 may be so licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers
- 4 registered under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 5 (3) If the license plates issued under this section are
- 6 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the license plates
- 7 shall be issued replacement license plates upon request and without
- 8 charge.
- 9 Sec. 3. Section 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 10 2009, is amended to read:
- 11 60-3,124 (1) Any person who is a veteran of the United
- 12 States Armed Forces, who was discharged or otherwise separated
- 13 with a characterization of honorable or general (under honorable
- 14 conditions), and who is classified by the United States Department
- 15 of Veterans Affairs as one hundred percent service-connected
- 16 disabled may, in addition to the application required in section
- 17 60-385, apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for license
- 18 plates designed by the department to indicate that the applicant is
- 19 a disabled veteran. The inscription on the license plates shall be
- 20 D.A.V. immediately below the license plate number to indicate that
- 21 the holder of the license plates is a disabled veteran.
- 22 (2) The plates shall be issued upon the applicant paying
- 23 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
- 24 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
- 25 is a disabled veteran. The additional fee shall be remitted to the

- 2 Operation Fund. Only one motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or
- 3 cabin trailer owned by the applicant shall be so licensed at any
- 4 one time. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or
- 5 cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any one
- 6 time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section 60-3,198
- 7 shall not be so licensed.
- 8 (3) If the license plates issued under this section are
- 9 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be
- 10 issued replacement license plates as provided in section 60-3,157.
- 11 Sec. 4. Original sections 60-3,122, 60-3,123, and
- 12 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2009, are repealed.
