- FOR AN ACT relating to courts; to amend section 25-2221, Reissue
 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for court
- 3 closure for inclement weather or other emergency as
- 4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 25-2221, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 25-2221 (1) Except as may be otherwise more specifically
- 4 provided, the period of time within which an act is to be done in
- 5 any action or proceeding shall be computed by excluding the day of
- 6 the act, event, or default after which the designated period of
- 7 time begins to run. The last day of the period so computed shall be
- 8 included unless it is a Saturday, a Sunday, or a day during which
- 9 the offices of courts of record may be legally closed as provided
- 10 in this section, in which event the period shall run until the end
- 11 of the next day on which the office will be open.
- 12 (2) All courts and their offices may be closed on
- 13 Saturdays, Sundays, days on which a specifically designated court
- 14 is closed by order of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court,
- 15 and these holidays: New Year's Day, January 1; Birthday of Martin
- 16 Luther King, Jr., the third Monday in January; President's Day,
- 17 the third Monday in February; Arbor Day, the last Friday in April;
- 18 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; Independence Day, July 4;
- 19 Labor Day, the first Monday in September; Columbus Day, the second
- 20 Monday in October; Veterans Day, November 11; Thanksgiving Day, the
- 21 fourth Thursday in November; the day after Thanksgiving; Christmas
- 22 Day, December 25; and all days or partial days declared by law or
- 23 proclamation of the Governor to be holidays. Such days or partial
- 24 <u>days</u> shall be designated as nonjudicial days for the entire day.
- 25 If any such holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be

1 a holiday. If any such holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding

- 2 Friday shall be a holiday. Court offices shall be open on all
- 3 other days except courts may be closed in case of inclement weather
- 4 or other emergency as provided in subsection (3) of this section.
- 5 If the date designated by the state for observance of any legal
- 6 holiday pursuant to this section, except Veterans Day, is different
- 7 from the date of observance of such holiday pursuant to a federal
- 8 holiday schedule, the federal holiday schedule shall be observed.
- 9 (3) In case of inclement weather or other emergency in
- 10 which instance a courthouse or other building housing a court is
- 11 closed by designation of the proper authorities, the presiding
- 12 judge of the court, or his or her designee, may order the court
- 13 <u>closed</u>. If the court is closed under such circumstances for
- 14 any period of time, then the entire day shall be designated a
- 15 nonjudicial day for that court and the clerk of the court shall
- 16 upon request of any party or upon direction of the presiding judge
- 17 of the court file a certificate in the court file of any case
- 18 certifying that the court was closed due to inclement weather or
- 19 other emergency and such certification shall be conclusive that the
- 20 day was a nonjudicial day.
