1	FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-6,349,
2	Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, sections 60-123,
3	60-137, 60-302, 60-339, and 60-605, Revised Statutes
4	Cumulative Supplement, 2008, and sections 60-101, 60-301,
5	and 60-601, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2009; to
6	allow operation of low-speed vehicles on highways as
7	prescribed; to require titling and registration for
8	low-speed vehicles; to harmonize provisions; and to
9	repeal the original sections.

Section 1. Section 60-101, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 17 manufacturer's vehicle identification number, the owner of the
- 18 low-speed vehicle may apply for a certificate of title by
- 19 presenting a manufacturer's statement of origin for the low-speed
- 20 vehicle, a statement that an inspection has been conducted on the
- 21 low-speed vehicle, and a vehicle identification number as described
- 22 in section 60-148. The certificate of title shall indicate the year
- 23 of the low-speed vehicle as the year application for title was made
- 24 and the make of the low-speed vehicle.

- 25 part existed on January 1, 2010, or (3) is designated by the

- 1 manufacturer as an off-road or low-speed vehicle.
- 2 Sec. 12. A low-speed vehicle may be operated on any
- 3 highway on which the speed limit is not more than thirty-five miles
- 4 per hour. Any person operating a low-speed vehicle as authorized
- 5 under this section shall have a valid Class O operator's license
- 6 and shall have liability insurance coverage for the low-speed
- 7 vehicle. The Department of Roads may prohibit the operation of
- 8 low-speed vehicles on any highway under its jurisdiction if it
- 9 determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of
- 10 public safety.

- 16 user: This vehicle as manufactured or sold is for off-road use
- 17 only. This section shall not apply to \underline{a} low-speed vehicle, as
- 18 applicable to its design, or to an electric personal assistive
- 19 mobility device.
