# LEGISLATIVE BILL 114

### A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

2008; to provide for operation of minitrucks on certain
highways as prescribed; to provide penalties; to
harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 60-601 Sections 60-601 to 60-6,377 and sections 2 to 9 of
- 4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Rules of
- 5 the Road.
- 6 Sec. 2. For purposes of sections 2 to 8 of this
- 7 act, minitruck means a foreign-manufactured import vehicle or
- 8 domestic-manufactured vehicle which (1) is powered by an internal
- 9 combustion engine with a piston or rotor displacement of one
- 10 thousand cubic centimeters or less, (2) is sixty-seven inches
- 11 or less in width, (3) has a dry weight of three thousand four
- 12 hundred pounds or less, (4) travels on four or more tires, (5)
- 13 has a top speed of approximately fifty-five miles per hour,
- 14 (6) is equipped with a bed or compartment for hauling, (7)
- 15 has an enclosed passenger cab, (8) is equipped with headlights,
- 16 taillights, turnsignals, windshield wipers, rearview mirror, and an
- occupant protection system, and (9) has a four-speed or five-speed
- 18 transmission.
- 19 Sec. 3. A minitruck shall not be subject to the Motor
- 20 Vehicle Certificate of Title Act or be required to be registered
- 21 <u>under the Motor Vehicle Registration Act.</u>
- 22 Sec. 4. (1) A minitruck shall not be operated on any
- 23 controlled-access highway with more than two marked traffic lanes,
- 24 and the crossing of any controlled-access highway with more than
- 25 two marked traffic lanes shall not be permitted. Subsections (2),

1 (3), and (5) through (8) of this section authorize and apply

- 2 to operation of a minitruck only on a highway other than a
- 3 controlled-access highway with more than two marked traffic lanes.
- 4 (2) A minitruck may be operated in accordance with the
- 5 operating requirements of subsection (3) of this section:
- 6 (a) Outside the corporate limits of a city, village, or
- 7 unincorporated village if incidental to the minitruck's use for
- 8 agricultural purposes;
- 9 (b) Within the corporate limits of a city or village
- 10 if authorized by the city or village by ordinance adopted in
- 11 accordance with this section; or
- 12 (c) Within an unincorporated village if authorized by the
- 13 county board of the county in which the unincorporated village is
- 14 located by resolution in accordance with this section.
- 15 (3) A minitruck may be operated as authorized in
- 16 subsection (2) of this section when such operation occurs only
- 17 between the hours of sunrise and sunset. Any person operating
- 18 a minitruck as authorized in subsection (2) of this section
- 19 shall have a valid Class O operator's license or a farm permit
- 20 as provided in section 60-4,126, shall have liability insurance
- 21 coverage for the minitruck while operating the minitruck on a
- 22 highway, and shall not operate the minitruck at a speed in excess
- 23 of thirty miles per hour. The person operating the minitruck shall
- 24 provide proof of such insurance coverage to any peace officer
- 25 requesting such proof within five days of such a request. When

1 operating a minitruck as authorized in subsection (2) of this

- 2 section, the headlights and taillights of the minitruck shall be
- 3 on.
- 4 (4) A minitruck may be operated without complying with
- 5 subsection (3) of this section on highways in parades which have
- 6 been authorized by the State of Nebraska or any department, board,
- 7 commission, or political subdivision of the state.
- 8 (5) Subject to subsection (1) of this section, the
- 9 crossing of a highway shall be permitted by a minitruck without
- 10 complying with subsection (3) of this section only if:
- 11 (a) The crossing is made at an angle of approximately
- 12 <u>ninety degrees to the direction of the highway and at a place where</u>
- no obstruction prevents a quick and safe crossing;
- 14 (b) The minitruck is brought to a complete stop before
- 15 crossing the shoulder or roadway of the highway;
- 16 (c) The operator yields the right-of-way to all oncoming
- 17 traffic that constitutes an immediate potential hazard;
- 18 (d) In crossing a divided highway, the crossing is made
- 19 only at an intersection of such highway with another highway; and
- 20 (e) Both the headlights and taillights of the minitruck
- 21 are on when the crossing is made.
- 22 (6) A city or village may adopt an ordinance authorizing
- 23 the operation of minitrucks within the corporate limits of the city
- 24 or village if the operation is in accordance with subsection (3) of
- 25 this section. The city or village may place other restrictions on

- 1 the operation of minitrucks within its corporate limits.
- 2 (7) A county board may adopt a resolution authorizing the
- 3 operation of minitrucks within any unincorporated village within
- 4 the county if the operation is in accordance with subsection (3)
- 5 of this section. The county may place other restrictions on the
- 6 operation of minitrucks within the unincorporated village.
- 7 Sec. 5. Every minitruck shall display lighted headlights
- 8 and taillights during the period of time from sunset to sunrise and
- 9 at any time when visibility is reduced due to insufficient light or
- 10 unfavorable atmospheric conditions.
- 11 Sec. 6. No person shall:
- 12 (1) Equip the exhaust system of a minitruck with a
- 13 cutout, bypass, or similar device;
- 14 (2) Operate a minitruck with an exhaust system so
- 15 modified; or
- 16 (3) Operate a minitruck with the spark arrester removed
- or modified except for use in closed-course competition events.
- 18 Sec. 7. Minitrucks participating in competitive events
- 19 may be exempted from sections 5 and 6 of this act at the discretion
- 20 of the Director of Motor Vehicles.
- 21 Sec. 8. If an accident results in the death of any person
- 22 or in the injury of any person which requires the treatment of the
- 23 person by a physician, the operator of each minitruck involved in
- 24 the accident shall give notice of the accident in the same manner
- 25 as provided in section 60-699.

Sec. 9. (1) Any person who violates sections 3 to 8 of

- 2 this act shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor, except that if
- 3 such person is convicted of a second or subsequent offense within
- 4 any period of one year, he or she shall be guilty of a Class II
- 5 misdemeanor.
- 6 (2) Any violation of such sections which is also a
- 7 violation under any other provision of Chapter 60 may be punished
- 8 under the penalty provisions applicable to the other violation.
- 9 Sec. 10. Original section 60-601, Revised Statutes
- 10 Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is repealed.
