A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Insurance Program;
 2 to amend section 84-1604, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 3 Nebraska; to provide for the inclusion of volunteer
 4 emergency responders, firefighters, and rescue squad
 5 members as prescribed; and to repeal the original
 6 section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 84-1604, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 84-1604 The coverages provided for by sections 84-1601
- 4 to 84-1615 shall be afforded to each permanent state employee who
- 5 works one-half or more of the regularly scheduled hours during each
- 6 pay period, commencing after thirty days of such employment, and
- 7 to each temporary employee only as described in subsection (2) of
- 8 section 84-1601, commencing after thirty days of such employment.
- 9 Permanent and temporary employees who are employed less than the
- 10 regularly scheduled hours as defined for a permanent employee shall
- 11 be entitled to state contributions on a proportionately reduced
- 12 basis.
- Volunteer emergency responders, firefighters, and rescue
- 14 squad personnel serving a volunteer department shall be deemed
- 15 state employees solely for purposes of health insurance coverage
- 16 under sections 84-1601 to 84-1615. Such volunteers shall pay
- 17 one hundred percent of the employee portion of the premium and
- 18 one hundred percent of the employer portion of the premium. For
- 19 purposes of this section, volunteer department means any volunteer
- 20 fire department or volunteer first-aid, rescue, ambulance, or
- 21 emergency squad or volunteer fire company, association, or
- 22 organization serving any city, village, or rural or suburban fire
- 23 protection district in this state by providing fire protection or
- 24 emergency response services for the purpose of protecting human
- 25 <u>life</u>, health, or property.

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1 The life and health insurance coverages provided by

- 2 sections 84-1601 to 84-1615 shall be totally independent of one
- 3 another and the loss experience and the rates for the two coverages
- 4 shall be maintained separate and apart from one another.
