Section 1. Section 28-718, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-718 There shall be a central register of child protection cases maintained in the department containing records 4 5 of all reports of child abuse or neglect opened for investigation as provided in section 28-713 and classified as either court 6 7 substantiated or inconclusive agency substantiated as provided in 8 section 28-720. The department may change records classified as 9 inconclusive prior to the effective date of this act to agency 10 substantiated.

Sec. 2. Section 28-720, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

13 28-720 All cases entered into the central register of
14 child protection cases maintained pursuant to section 28-718 shall
15 be classified as one of the following:

16 (1) Court substantiated, if a court of competent 17 jurisdiction has entered a judgment of guilty against the subject 18 of the report of child abuse or neglect upon a criminal complaint, 19 indictment, or information or there has been an adjudication of 20 jurisdiction of a juvenile court over the child under subdivision 21 (3) (a) of section 43-247 which relates or pertains to the report 22 of child abuse or neglect;

3 (3) Inconclusive, Agency substantiated, if the
4 department's determination of child abuse or neglect against
5 the subject of the report of child abuse or neglect was made,
6 supported, by a preponderance of the evidence, and based upon an
7 investigation pursuant to section 28-713.
