1	FOR AN ACT relating to constitutional officers; to amend sections
2	49-1401 and 49-1463.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
3	Supplement, 2008; to require financial disclosure
4	reports; to provide a late filing fee; to harmonize
5	provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
6	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1	Section 1. Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2	Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
3	49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,141 and section 2 of
4	this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political
5	Accountability and Disclosure Act.
6	Sec. 2. (1) A candidate for the office of or person
7	serving as Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public
8	Accounts, State Treasurer, or Attorney General shall file a
9	financial disclosure report at the time he or she files a candidate
10	filing form pursuant to the Election Act and on the first day of
11	each calendar quarter thereafter until he or she is no longer a
12	candidate for such office or serving in such office. A candidate
13	for the office of or person serving as Lieutenant Governor shall
14	file a financial disclosure report at the time he or she files a
15	written consent pursuant to section 32-619.01 and on the first day
16	of each calendar quarter thereafter until he or she is no longer a
17	candidate for the office of Lieutenant Governor or serving as the
18	Lieutenant Governor. Any person serving in any of such offices on
19	the effective date of this act shall file a financial disclosure
20	report on the first day of the first calendar quarter which begins
21	after the effective date of this act.
22	(2) A financial disclosure report shall include the full
23	name of the individual filing the report, the office for which he

24 <u>or she is a candidate or which he or she holds, the dollar amount</u> 25 <u>of any salary or wages received on a calendar-year basis, either as</u>

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cash, goods, or services, from any other person, the full name and 1 2 address of each person from whom the individual filing the report 3 receives salary or wages, and an estimate of the amount of time spent in a calendar year in return for such salary or wages. 4 (3) Any person who fails to file a financial disclosure 5 report with the commission under this section shall pay to the 6 commission a late filing fee of twenty-five dollars for each day 7 8 the report remains not filed in violation of this section, not to 9 exceed seven hundred fifty dollars. 10 Sec. 3. Section 49-1463.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative 11 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read: 12 49-1463.01 (1) A person required to pay a late filing 13 fee imposed under section 32-1604, 32-1604.01, 32-1606.01, 49-1449, 49-1458, 49-1463, 49-1467, 49-1469.08, 49-1478.01, or 49-1479.01 or 14 15 section 2 of this act may apply to the commission for relief. The 16 commission by order may reduce the amount of a late filing fee 17 imposed and waive any or all of the interest due on the fee upon 18 a showing by such person that (a) the circumstances indicate no 19 intent to file late, (b) the person has not been required to pay 20 late filing fees for two years prior to the time the filing was 21 due, (c) the late filing shows that less than five thousand dollars 22 was raised, received, or expended during the reporting period, and (d) a reduction of the late fees and waiver of interest would not 23 24 frustrate the purposes of the Nebraska Political Accountability and 25 Disclosure Act.

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1 (2) A person required to pay a late filing fee imposed 2 for failure to file a statement of exemption under subsection (2) 3 of section 49-1459 may apply to the commission for relief. The 4 commission by order may reduce or waive the late filing fee and 5 waive any or all of the interest due on the fee, and the person 6 shall not be required to make a showing as provided by subsection 7 (1) of this section.
