1	FOR AN ACT relating to cities of the metropolitan class; to amend
2	section 14-109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3	change provisions relating to vehicle registration and
4	fees as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 14-109, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

LB 174

3 14-109 The council shall have power to tax for revenue, license, and regulate pawnbrokers, peddlers, auctioneers, brokers, 4 5 hawkers, commission merchants, showmen, jugglers, innkeepers, liquor dealers, toll bridges, ferries, insurance, telegraph and 6 7 express companies and vendors of patents. Such tax may include both 8 a tax for revenue and license. If the applicant is an individual, 9 an application for a license shall include the applicant's social 10 security number. The city council shall have power to raise revenue 11 by levying and collecting a tax on any occupation or business 12 within the limits of the city and regulate the same by ordinance. 13 All such taxes shall be uniform in respect to the class upon 14 which they are imposed. All scientific and literary lectures and 15 entertainments shall be exempt from taxation, as well as concerts 16 and all other musical entertainments given exclusively by the citizens of the city. It shall be the duty of the city clerk to 17 18 deliver to the city treasurer the certified copy of the ordinance 19 levying such tax, and the city clerk shall append thereto a warrant 20 requiring the city treasurer to collect such tax. The city council 21 shall also have power to require any person, firm, or corporation 22 owning or using any vehicle in a city of the metropolitan class 23 annually to register such vehicle in such manner as may be provided and to require such person to pay an annual registration fee 24 25 therefor and to require the payment of registration fees upon the

1 change of ownership of such vehicle. All registration fees which 2 may be thus provided for shall be credited to a separate fund of 3 the city, thereby created, to be used exclusively for the repairing 4 of streets in such city. No registration fee shall be required 5 where a vehicle is used but temporarily in such city for a period 6 of not more than one week.
