1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation

6	harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 86-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 86-101 Sections 86-101 to 86-163 and section 2 of
- 4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
- 5 Telecommunications Regulation Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) A telecommunications company that proposes to
- 7 sell any exchange owned by the company shall submit an application
- 8 to the commission on a form provided by the commission for approval
- 9 of the sale. Within twenty days after receipt of the application,
- 10 the commission shall publish notice of the proposed sale in a
- 11 newspaper of general circulation in each county in which an
- 12 exchange proposed for sale provides basic local exchange service.
- 13 The notice shall inform the residents of this state of their right
- 14 to file a petition of intervention or submit a comment. Such filing
- 15 or submission shall occur within fifteen days after publication
- 16 of the notice. The telecommunications company shall reimburse the
- 17 commission for the cost of such publication.
- 18 (2) In approving or rejecting the application, the
- 19 commission shall consider the protection of the public interest
- 20 and to the extent applicable to the exchange proposed to be sold,
- 21 (a) the adequacy of local telephone service, (b) the reasonableness
- 22 of rates for the local telephone service, (c) the provision of 911
- 23 service, enhanced-911 service, and other public safety services,
- 24 (d) the payment of taxes by the company, and (e) the ability and
- 25 commitment of the telecommunications company to provide modern,

1 state-of-the-art telecommunications services. If the commission

- 2 does not hold a hearing on the application, it shall issue an
- 3 order of approval or rejection within forty-five days after the
- 4 publication of the notice pursuant to subsection (1) of this
- 5 section. If the commission holds a hearing on the application, it
- 6 shall issue an order of approval or rejection within one hundred
- 7 twenty days after the publication of such notice. The order may
- 8 include conditions that the commission deems necessary to ensure
- 9 protection of the public interest pursuant to the criteria set
- 10 forth in this subsection.
- 11 (3) For purposes of this section:
- 12 (a) Exchange means (i) switching, transmission, and
- 13 other equipment and (ii) facilities and associated permits,
- 14 authorizations, service rights, customer contracts, and related
- 15 assets by which a telecommunications company provides basic local
- 16 exchange service within a local exchange area; and
- 17 (b) Sell or sale means the transfer, for consideration,
- 18 of title to the assets comprising an exchange. Sell or sale does
- 19 not include a transaction such as a merger, a consolidation, stock
- 20 sale, financing transaction, or other non-asset sale transaction.
