 2008; to change provisions relating to aid to natural

 resources districts; to provide an operative date; and to

 repeal the original section.

Section 1. Section 77-27,137.02, Revised Statutes

- 2 Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 77-27,137.02 The appropriation provided for in section
- 4 77-27,136 for aid to natural resources districts shall be
- 5 distributed to the various natural resources districts of the
- 6 state on the basis of the ratio of the total amount of property
- 7 taxes levied by the particular natural resources district to the
- 8 total amount of property taxes levied by all natural resources
- 9 districts within the state based on amounts stated in the
- 10 most recent certificate of taxes levied statement and schedules
- 11 submitted by each county to the Tax Commissioner pursuant to
- 12 section 77-1613.01. For purposes of calculating the ratio in this
- 13 section, in determining the total amount of property taxes levied
- 14 by natural resources districts, the total shall exclude those
- 15 property taxes levied for the payment of principal or interest
- 16 on bonds. The Tax Commissioner shall determine the amount to be
- 17 distributed to the various natural resources districts and certify
- 18 such amounts by voucher to the Director of Administrative Services.
- 19 Each amount shall be distributed in seven as nearly as possible
- 20 equal monthly payments between the fifth and twentieth day of each
- 21 month beginning December 1, 1982, and each December thereafter.
- 22 The State Treasurer shall, between the fifth and twentieth day
- 23 of each month, notify the Director of Administrative Services of
- 24 the amount of funds available in the General Fund for payment
- 25 purposes. The Director of Administrative Services shall, upon

1 receipt of such notification and vouchers, draw warrants against

- 2 funds appropriated. The proceeds of the payments received by the
- 3 various natural resources districts shall be credited to the
- 4 general fund of the district.
- 5 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2010.
- 6 Sec. 3. Original section 77-27,137.02, Revised Statutes
- 7 Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is repealed.
