#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Criminal Code; to amend section

  28-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide

  requirements, violations, and penalties for the purchase

  of spray paint and industrial-strength marking pens by

  a minor; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the

  original section.

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1350 and section 2 of this
- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) No person shall sell, give away, exchange,
- 6 deliver, or, except as provided in subdivision (2)(b) of
- 7 this section, permit the sale or gift of spray paint or any
- 8 industrial-strength marking pen to any minor. Any person violating
- 9 this subsection shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.
- 10 (2)(a) No minor shall purchase, receive, or otherwise
- 11 acquire or attempt to purchase, receive, or otherwise acquire spray
- 12 paint or any industrial-strength marking pen by misrepresentation
- 13 of age. Any person violating this subdivision shall be guilty of a
- 14 Class III misdemeanor.
- 15 (b) It shall be lawful for a parent or guardian
- 16 eighteen years of age or older to procure spray paint or any
- industrial-strength marking pen for his or her minor child.
- 18 (3) To establish proof of age for the purpose of
- 19 purchasing spray paint or any industrial-strength marking
- 20 pen, a person shall present or display a valid driver's or
- 21 operator's license, Nebraska state identification card, military
- 22 identification card, alien registration card, or passport.
- 23 (4) In any prosecution of or any proceeding against any
- 24 person charged with having made such sale to a minor, proof of the
- 25 <u>following shall be an absolute defense to the charge:</u>

1 (a) (i) The purchaser falsely represented in writing and

- 2 supported with other documentary proof that he or she was of legal
- 3 age to purchase spray paint or any industrial-strength marking pen;
- 4 (ii) The appearance of such purchaser was such that an
- 5 ordinary and prudent person would believe that such appearance
- 6 conformed to any documentary description of appearance presented by
- 7 the purchaser; and
- 8 <u>(iii) The seller was acting in good faith, in reliance</u>
- 9 upon the written representation, other documentary evidence, and
- 10 the appearance of the purchaser, and in the belief the purchaser
- 11 was of legal age to make such purchase; or
- 12 (b) The seller was acting with the knowledge of and in
- 13 cooperation with a duly authorized law enforcement officer.
