 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 25-3007 The Civil Legal Services Program is created. 4 Appropriations to the program and money in the Civil Legal Services 5 Fund shall be used to provide grants for civil legal services 6 to eligible low-income persons. The State Court Administrator 7 <u>Commission on Public Advocacy</u> shall distribute grants pursuant to 8 section 25-3008.

12 on Public Advocacy shall establish guidelines for submission of
13 applications for grants to provide civil legal services to eligible

16 (a) Be a nonprofit organization chartered in Nebraska;
17 (b) Employ or contract with attorneys admitted to
18 practice before the Nebraska Supreme Court and the United States
19 District Courts;

20 (c) Have offices located throughout the state;

(d) Have as its principal purpose and mission the delivery of civil legal services to eligible low-income persons who are residents of Nebraska;

1 (f) Be a recipient of financial assistance for the 2 delivery of civil legal services from the Legal Services 3 Corporation established by the federal Legal Services Corporation 4 Act, 42 U.S.C. 2996 et seq.; and

5 (g) Certify that any grant funds received pursuant to 6 this section will be used to supplement any existing funds used 7 by the applicant and that such funds will not replace other funds 8 appropriated or awarded by a state agency to provide civil legal 9 services to any eligible low-income person.

10 (2) A civil legal services provider seeking a grant 11 under this section shall file an application with the State Court 12 Administrator commission on forms provided by the administrator. 13 commission. The application shall include a place for the provider 14 to certify to the administrator commission that it will provide 15 free civil legal services to eligible low-income persons upon 16 receipt of a grant under this section.

17 (3) The State Court Administrator <u>commission</u> shall review 18 the applications and determine which civil legal services providers 19 shall receive grants under this section and the amount of the 20 grants. Grant recipients shall use the grant funds to provide free 21 civil legal services to eligible low-income persons.

(4) An independent certified public accountant shall annually audit the books and accounts of each grant recipient. The grant recipients shall provide the results of such audit to the State Court Administrator. commission.
