Section 1. Section 79-954, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 79-954 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, if If a disability beneficiary under the age of 4 5 sixty-five years is restored to active service as a school employee or if the examining physician certifies that the person is no 6 7 longer disabled for service as a school employee, the school or 8 disability retirement allowance shall cease. If the beneficiary 9 again becomes a school employee, he or she shall become a member of 10 the retirement system. Any prior service certificate, on the basis 11 of which his or her creditable service was computed at the time 12 of his or her retirement for disability, shall be restored to full 13 force and effect upon his or her again becoming a member of such 14 retirement system.

15 (2) If a disability beneficiary under the age of sixty-five years is restored to active service as a school employee 16 17 and the examining physician certifies that the beneficiary has 18 a permanent disability, the beneficiary shall retain his or her 19 disability retirement allowance if the beneficiary's monthly income 20 does not exceed the applicable Substantial Gainful Activity amount 21 determined annually by the Social Security Administration for blind 22 and non-blind individuals.
