- 3 28-323 (1) A person commits the offense of domestic
- 4 assault in the third degree if he or she:
- 5 (a) Intentionally, and knowingly, or recklessly causes
- 6 bodily injury to his or her intimate partner; or
- 7 (b) Places, by physical menace, his or her Threatens an
- 8 intimate partner in fear of imminent bodily injury. a menacing
- 9 manner.
- 10 (2) A person commits the offense of domestic assault in
- 11 the second degree if he or she intentionally and knowingly causes
- 12 bodily injury to his or her intimate partner with a dangerous
- 13 instrument.
- 14 (3) A person commits the offense of domestic assault in
- 15 the first degree if he or she intentionally and knowingly causes
- 16 serious bodily injury to his or her intimate partner.
- 17 (4) Violation of subsection (1) of this section is a
- 18 Class I misdemeanor, except that for any second or subsequent
- 19 violation of such subsection, within twelve years after the date of
- 20 the current conviction, any person so offending against the same
- 21 intimate partner is guilty of a Class IV felony.
- 22 (5) Violation of subsection (2) of this section is
- 23 a Class IIIA felony, except that for any second or subsequent
- 24 violation of such subsection, within twelve years after the date of
- 25 the current conviction, any person so offending against the same

- 7 (7) For purposes of this section, intimate partner means
- 8 a spouse; a former spouse; persons who have a child in common
- 9 whether or not they have been married or lived together at
- 10 any time; and persons who are or were involved in a dating
- 11 relationship. For purposes of this subsection, dating relationship
- 12 means frequent, intimate associations primarily characterized by
- 13 the expectation of affectional or sexual involvement, but does not
- 14 include a casual relationship or an ordinary association between
- 15 persons in a business or social context.
