- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 6 intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly endanger the physical
- 7 or mental health or safety of another person for the purpose
- 8 of initiation into, admission into, affiliation with, promotion
- 9 within, or continued membership with any criminal gang. Consent to
- 10 such endangerment shall not be a defense.
- 11 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to request,
- 12 induce, require, direct, or cause another person to engage in any
- 13 <u>criminal act for the purpose of initiation into, admission into,</u>
- 14 affiliation with, promotion within, or continued membership with
- 15 any criminal gang.
- 16 (3) It shall be unlawful for any person to request,
- 17 induce, require, direct, or cause another person to be subjected
- 18 to sexual contact or sexual penetration as those terms are defined
- 19 in section 28-318 for the purpose of initiation into, admission
- 20 into, affiliation with, promotion within, or continued membership
- 21 with any criminal gang. Consent to such sexual contact or sexual
- 22 penetration shall not be a defense.
- 23 (4) For purposes of this section, criminal gang means
- 24 any organization, association, or group of three or more persons,
- 25 whether formal or informal, having as one of its primary activities

1 the commission of one or more criminal acts, having a common

- 2 name or common identifying sign or symbol, and whose members
- 3 individually or collectively engage in or have engaged in a pattern
- 4 of criminal acts.
- 5 (5) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a
