#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-301,
  60-3,104, and 60-3,130.04, Revised Statutes Cumulative
  Supplement, 2008; to provide for Nebraska agriculture
  license plates; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
  the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 19 Sec. 3. (1) The department shall design license plates
- 20 to be known as Nebraska agriculture license plates. The department
- 21 <u>shall, in designing the plates:</u>
- 22 (a) Use a design, background, and printing as the
- 23 department in consultation with the Department of Agriculture
- 24 determines would best represent Nebraska agriculture and provide
- 25 suitable reflection and contrast;

1 (b) Create a design to reflect support for the state's

- 2 agricultural history and livestock industry; and
- 3 (c) Select a design on the basis of limiting the
- 4 manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than or
- 5 equal to the amount charged for license plates pursuant to section
- 6 60-3,102.
- 7 (2) One type of Nebraska agriculture license plate shall
- 8 be numbered plates. The Department of Motor Vehicles shall:
- 9 (a) Number the plates with a registration number of five
- 10 or fewer letters and numerals, using letters and numerals the size
- 11 of which maximizes legibility; and
- 12 (b) Not use a county designation or any characters on the
- 13 plates.
- 14 (3) One type of Nebraska agriculture license plate shall
- 15 be personalized message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject
- 16 to the same conditions specified for personalized message license
- 17 plates in subsection (2) of section 60-3,118. The characters used
- 18 shall consist only of letters and numerals of the same size and
- 19 design and shall comply with the requirements of subdivision (1)(a)
- 20 of section 60-3,100. A maximum of seven characters may be used.
- 21 Sec. 4. (1) Beginning January 1, 2010, a person may
- 22 apply to the department for Nebraska agriculture license plates
- 23 in lieu of regular license plates on an application prescribed
- 24 and provided by the department for any motor vehicle, trailer,
- 25 semitrailer, or cabin trailer, except for a motor vehicle or

1 trailer registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant receiving a

- 2 Nebraska agriculture license plate for a farm truck with a gross
- 3 weight of over sixteen tons or for a commercial motor vehicle
- 4 registered for a gross weight of five tons or over shall affix
- 5 the appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The department shall
- 6 make forms available for applications for the plates when they are
- 7 designed.
- 8 (2) (a) Each application for initial issuance of numbered
- 9 Nebraska agriculture license plates shall be accompanied by a fee
- 10 of fifteen dollars. The department shall remit the fees to the
- 11 State Treasurer. An application for renewal of such plates shall
- 12 be accompanied by a fee of fifteen dollars. The county treasurer
- 13 or designated county official shall remit the renewal fees to the
- 14 State Treasurer.
- 15 (b) The State Treasurer shall credit forty-three percent
- 16 of the fees for initial issuance and renewal of such plates
- 17 <u>collected under subdivision</u> (a) of this subsection to the
- 18 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and fifty-seven percent of
- 19 such fees to the Highway Trust Fund.
- 20 (c) Each application for initial issuance of personalized
- 21 message Nebraska agriculture license plates shall be accompanied by
- 22 a fee of forty dollars. The department shall remit the fees to the
- 23 State Treasurer. An application for renewal of such plates shall
- 24 be accompanied by a fee of forty dollars. The county treasurer
- 25 or designated county official shall remit the renewal fees to the

- 1 State Treasurer.
- 2 (d) The State Treasurer shall credit forty-three percent
- 3 of the fees for initial issuance and renewal of such plates
- 4 collected under subdivision (c) of this subsection to the
- 5 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and fifty-seven percent of
- 6 such fees to the Highway Trust Fund.
- 7 (3) When the department receives an application for
- 8 Nebraska agriculture license plates, the department shall deliver
- 9 the plates to the county treasurer or designated county official
- 10 of the county in which the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 11 or cabin trailer is registered. The county treasurer or designated
- 12 <u>county official shall issue the Nebraska agriculture license plates</u>
- 13 in lieu of regular license plates when the applicant complies with
- 14 the other provisions of the Motor Vehicle Registration Act for
- 15 registration of the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin
- 16 trailer. If Nebraska agriculture license plates are lost, stolen,
- 17 or mutilated, the licensee shall be issued replacement license
- 18 plates pursuant to section 60-3,157.
- 19 (4)(a) The owner of a motor vehicle, trailer,
- 20 semitrailer, or cabin trailer bearing the Nebraska agriculture
- 21 license plates may apply to the county treasurer or designated
- 22 county official to have such plates transferred to a motor vehicle,
- 23 trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer other than the motor
- 24 vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer for which such
- 25 plates were originally purchased if such motor vehicle, trailer,

1 semitrailer, or cabin trailer is owned by the owner of the plates.

- 2 (b) The owner may have the unused portion of the fee for
- 3 the Nebraska agriculture license plates credited to the other motor
- 4 vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer which will bear the
- 5 plates at the rate of eight and one-third percent per month for
- 6 each full month left in the registration period.
- 7 (c) Application for such transfer shall be accompanied by
- 8 a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection
- 9 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
- 10 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 11 Sec. 5. Section 60-3,130.04, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 12 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 13 60-3,130.04 (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible
- 14 for registration under section 60-3,130 may use a license plate
- 15 or plates designed by this state in the year corresponding to the
- 16 model year when the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of the plates
- 17 designed pursuant to section 60-3,130.03 subject to the approval of
- 18 the department. The department shall inspect the plate or plates
- 19 and may approve the plate or plates if it is determined that the
- 20 model-year license plate or plates are legible and serviceable and
- 21 that the license plate numbers do not conflict with or duplicate
- 22 other numbers assigned and in use. An original-issued license plate
- 23 or plates that have been restored to original condition may be used
- 24 when approved by the department.
- 25 (2) The department may consult with a recognized car club

1 in determining whether the year of the license plate or plates

- 2 to be used corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was
- 3 manufactured.
- 4 (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the
- 5 license plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner
- 6 of a historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even
- 7 for years in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in
- 8 general.
- 9 (4) License plates used pursuant to this section
- 10 corresponding to the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall
- 11 not be personalized message license plates, Pearl Harbor license
- 12 plates, prisoner-of-war license plates, disabled veteran license
- 13 plates, Purple Heart license plates, amateur radio station license
- 14 plates, Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates, or handicapped or
- 15 disabled person license plates, or Nebraska agriculture license
- 16 plates.
- 17 Sec. 6. Original sections 60-301, 60-3,104, and
- 18 60-3,130.04, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008, are
- 19 repealed.
