Section 83-1201, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 83-1201 Sections 83-1201 to 83-1226 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Developmental 4 5 Disabilities Services Act. 6 Sec. 2. (1) The department shall not close any 7 state-owned or state-operated facility that provides residential 8 services to persons with developmental disabilities without 9 specific legislation directing closure. If the department intends 10 to seek legislation directing it to close any such facility, 11 the department shall provide written notice at least sixty days 12 prior to the next legislative session of its intent to close the 13 facility: 14 (a) To the Clerk of the Legislature; and 15 (b) By registered mail, to each resident of the facility, his or her immediate family, if known, and his or her guardian. 16 17 (2) The notice shall include: 18 (a) Estimated timelines for the implementation of the 19 closure of the facility; 20 (b) The types and array of available and accessible 21 community-based services for persons with developmental 22 disabilities who reside in the facility; 23 (c) The rights of persons with developmental 24 disabilities;

25 (d) The process used to develop a community living plan

3	(e) Individual and community monitoring and safeguards to
4	protect health and safety; and
5	(f) The process to be used to transfer ownership of the
6	facility or the state's plan to reuse the property.

9	Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
10	when passed and approved according to law.
