- 8 (2) The Small Claims Court shall have subject matter
- 9 jurisdiction in civil matters when the plaintiff seeks to
- 10 disaffirm, avoid, or rescind a contract or agreement for the
- 11 purchase of goods or services not in excess of the jurisdictional
- 12 amount specified in subsection (4) of this section, exclusive of
- 13 interest and costs.
- 14 (3) The Small Claims Court shall have jurisdiction when
- 15 the party defendant or his or her agent resides or is doing
- 16 business within the county or when the cause of action arose within
- 17 the county.
- 18 (4) The jurisdictional amount was one thousand five
- 19 hundred dollars through June 30, 1990, one thousand eight hundred
- 20 dollars from July 1, 1990, through June 30, 1995, and two thousand
- 21 one hundred dollars from July 1, 1995, through June 30, 2000. The
- 22 jurisdictional amount is two thousand four hundred dollars from
- 23 July 1, 2000, through June 30, 2005. is five thousand dollars from
- 24 <u>July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2015.</u>
- 25 The Supreme Court shall continue to adjust the

1 jurisdictional limit for the Small Claims Court every fifth year

- 2 commencing July 1, 2000. 2015. The adjusted jurisdictional amount
- 3 shall be equal to the then current jurisdictional amount adjusted
- 4 by the average percentage change in the unadjusted Consumer Price
- 5 Index for All Urban Consumers published by the Federal Bureau of
- 6 Labor Statistics for the five-year period preceding the adjustment
- 7 date. The jurisdictional amount shall be rounded to the nearest
- 8 one-hundred-dollar amount.
- 9 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2010.
- 10 Sec. 3. Original section 25-2802, Reissue Revised
- 11 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 12 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 13 when passed and approved according to law.
