A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to real property; to amend sections 25-1326,
2	25-1327, 25-2144, and 77-1912, Reissue Revised Statutes
3	of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to certain
4	forced sales; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the
5	original sections; and to declare an emergency.
6	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 25-1326, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

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25-1326 (1) Real property may be conveyed by <u>a</u> master (<u>commissioner commissioners</u> (1) when (a) by an order or judgment in an action or a proceeding, a party is ordered to convey such property to another, and he shall neglect or refuse <u>he</u> or she <u>neglects or refuses</u> to comply with such order or judgment; (2) when <u>or (b)</u> specific real property is required to be sold under an order or judgment of the court.

10 (2) A master commissioner may, for any cause he or she 11 deems expedient, postpone the sale of all or any portion of the 12 real property from time to time until it is completed and, in 13 every such case, notice of postponement shall be given by public 14 declaration thereof by such master commissioner at the time and 15 place last appointed for the sale. No other notice of the postponed 16 sale need be given unless the sale is postponed for longer than 17 forty-five days beyond the day designated in the notice of sale in 18 which event the notice thereof shall be given in the same manner as the original notice of sale is required to be given. 19

20 Sec. 2. Section 25-1327, Reissue Revised Statutes of
21 Nebraska, is amended to read:

22 25-1327 A sheriff may act as a master commissioner under 23 the provisions of section 25-1326, subdivision (2). subdivision 24 (1)(b) of section 25-1326. Sales made under the same such 25 subdivision shall conform in all respects to the laws regulating

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1 sales of land upon execution.

Sec. 3. Section 25-2144, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

25-2144 (1) All sales of mortgaged premises under a 4 5 decree shall be made by a sheriff or some other person authorized by the court in the county where the premises or some part of 6 them are situated. In \div and in all cases where the sheriff shall 7 8 make makes such sale he or she shall act in his or her official 9 capacity, he shall be liable on his or her official bond for all 10 his or her acts therein, and he shall receive the same compensation 11 as is provided by law for like services upon sales under execution. 12 (2) The sheriff or other person conducting the sale may, 13 for any cause he or she deems expedient, postpone the sale of all 14 or any portion of the real property from time to time until it is 15 completed and, in every such case, notice of postponement shall be given by public declaration thereof by the sheriff or such other 16 17 person at the time and place last appointed for the sale. No other 18 notice of the postponed sale need be given unless the sale is 19 postponed for longer than forty-five days beyond the day designated 20 in the notice of sale in which event notice thereof shall be given 21 in the same manner as the original notice of sale is required to be 22 given.

Sec. 4. Section 77-1912, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

25 77-1912 (1) The sheriff shall sell the real property

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in the same manner provided by law for a sale on execution 1 2 and shall at once pay the proceeds thereof to the clerk of 3 the district court. Any governmental subdivision of the state, municipal corporation, or drainage or irrigation district to which 4 5 any part of the taxes included in the decree of foreclosure is due may purchase any real property sold at sheriff's sale. The 6 7 provisions of the law for the protection of the purchasers at tax 8 sales shall apply to purchasers at foreclosure sales provided for 9 in this section. The sheriff or officer conducting the sale shall 10 not be entitled to any commission on the money received and paid 11 out on foreclosure sales provided for herein. 12 (2) The sheriff or officer conducting the sale may, for 13 any cause he or she deems expedient, postpone the sale of all or 14 any portion of the real property from time to time until it is 15 completed and, in every such case, notice of postponement shall be 16 given by public declaration thereof by the sheriff or officer at 17 the time and place last appointed for the sale. No other notice of

18 the postponed sale need be given unless the sale is postponed for 19 longer then forty-five days beyond the day designated in the notice 20 of sale in which event notice shall be given in the same manner in 21 the original notice of sale is required to be given.

22 Sec. 5. Original sections 25-1326, 25-1327, 25-2144, and 23 77-1912, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.

24 Sec. 6. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 25 when passed and approved according to law.

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
